PAC Women's Tennis Player of the Week

AMY BROWELL Westminster College

Freshman - #1-2 singles/#1 doubles Gibsonia, Pa./Pine-Richland H.S.

Browell was a perfect 4-0 last week (2-0 at #5 singles, 2-0 at #3 doubles), leading Westminster to a five-match win streak after posting wins over PAC foes Thiel (8-1) and W&J (7-2).

Also nominated was senior **Katie Navarra** of Bethany, senior **Megan Hulick** of Grove City, senior **Terra Naviglia** of Washington & Jefferson, and sophomore **Jenn Knight** of Waynesburg.

Bethany Bison

The Bison women's tennis team went 2-1 last week, defeating Washington and Jefferson 7-2 on the road and also winning at Frostburg State, 9-0. The Bison lost at Grove City, 9-0. The Bison are now 4-4 overall this season and 1-3 in the PAC. Against W&J, BC won first (Katie Navarra), second (Hillary Norman), third (August Gardner) and fourth singles (Lindsay Caparese) ... Navarra and Norman also won first doubles, while Caparese and Carissa Moore won second doubles and Gardner and Ali Viveros won at No. 3 ... Against Frostburg State, only one Bobcat won a single set in the sweep ... The closest match was at No. 2 doubles, where Caparese and Erica Smith won 8-6.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson dropped to 1-4 overall after being defeated by Bethany and Westminster last week by 7-2 margins ... In the loss to the Bison, senior Cassandra NiCastro picked up a 6-1, 6-3 victory at No. 6 singles and sophomore Jennifer O'Hara recorded a 6-1, 6-2 win at No. 5 singles ... Senior Terra Naviglia was the lone President to win a singles match versus the Lady Titans as she avenged a loss earlier in the season to WC's Dana Larson by notching a 6-4, 1-6, 6-3 decision at No. 2 singles ... Naviglia and senior Jennifer Scott also picked up an 8-1 victory at the No. 1 doubles position ... The Presidents host Grove City and Waynesburg this week in PAC matches and will also entertain Chatham on Saturday at 1:00 pm.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City improved to 4-1 by blanking Bethany ... Megan Hulick, Nicole Leasure, Julie Crewson, Kristin McNally and Lindsay Hosler all won a pair of matches against the Bison ... Leasure won her singles match 6-0, 6-0 ... Crewson, Hosler, Hulick and McNally all played in ITA Southeast Region play this weekend, posting an aggregate 8-8 record ... McNally advanced to the quarterfinals of the blue singles draw while Hulick went 1-1 in the main singles draw ... Hulick and Crewson advanced to the consolation semifinals in the main doubles draw, going 2-2 overall ... Three of Grove City's next four matches are away from home, including a PAC match at Washington and Jefferson Tuesday.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg extended its winning steak to four with a 7-2 victory over Penn State-Altoona Tuesday ... Freshman Katie Kravits continued her strong play at No. 2 singles, winning her match in straight sets for her team-leading sixth singles win of the season ... Sophomores Beth Conlon and Jenn Knight, along with junior Rebecca Greene each recorded multiple wins in the match ... Conlon, Greene, Mindy Hall, Knight, and Kravits traveled to the Mary Washington this weekend to compete in the ITA Regional Tournament ... Kravits won her first round singles match, before losing in the second round ... In doubles play, Conlon and Knight defeated a team from ranked Washington College, but lost to a seeded team from Johns Hopkins.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel dropped its only match last week, falling at home to Westminster 8-1 ... The number one doubles duo of freshmen **Monica Lewis** and **Sarah Barefoot** defeated Westminter College's **Amy Caliguiri** and **Sara Belsito** 8-5 while the number two doubles team of freshmen **Ashley Crothers** and **Anika Backstram** lost 8-4 to the Lady Titan team of **Dana Larson** and **Christina Commisso** ...
