PAC Women's Tennis Player of the Week

LISA MCLAUGHLIN Washington & Jefferson College Sophomore - #5 singles/#3 doubles McDonald, Pa./Fort Cherry H.S.

McLaughlin went 4-0 for the Presidents (2-0 singles, 2-0 doubles) last week as W&J improved to 6-4 overall with dual wins over Frostburg State (6-3) and PAC rival Thomas More (5-4). She won both singles matches at #5, while winnign at #3 doubles vs. FSU and #1 doubles vs. TMC.

Also nominated was senior **Hillary Norman** of Bethany, junior **Lindsay Hosler** of Grove City, junior **Whitney Reis** of Thomas More, and freshman **Alyson Lingle** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

The Bison evened their record at 5-5 with a convincing win over Westminster Tuesday but then dropped their final two matches of the week at Saint Vincent and Grove City ... In the Westminster win **Hillary Norman**, **Lindsay**

Caprarese, **August Gardner** and **Erica Smith** were all doublewinners ... Smith dropped her first set at #5 singles, but rebounded to win the next two, including a 10-0 win in a super-tiebreaker in the third set ... BC fell by an 8-1 count at future PAC foe Saint Vincent ... The lone win came at first singles, as Norman won 6-0, 6-2 for her seventh consecutive singles triumph ... That streak was stopped in a 9-0 loss at Grove City, the 18-time defending PAC champion.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City improved to 5-0 in the PAC last week with 9-0 wins over Waynesburg and Bethany ... Grove City did not drop a set in either PAC match ... **Tamara Nations** earned a 6-0, 6-0 win at second singles against

Waynesburg while fellow freshman **Chris Sager** won 6-0, 6-0 at sixth singles against Bethany ... Senior **Jenna Powell** earned Grove City's lone win against NCAA Division II Clarion Thursday, winning 6-1, 7-6 at sixth singles ... The 8-1 loss at Clarion snapped Grove City's six-match win streak as well as the Wolverines' 11-match road win streak ... Grove City faces three PAC foes on the road, visiting Westminster, Bethany and Thomas More this week ... Grove City closes the regular season with three straight home matches.



Thomas More Saints

The Saints dropped 5-4 matches to Midway and PAC rival Washington & Jefferson last week ... In the Midway

loss, the Saints actually won more of the matches played, losing by forfeit in sixth singles and third doubles ... **Emily Prescott** was the lone TMC player to notch victories in both singles and doubles against W&J.



Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel women's tennis team dropped their only match last week, falling at home to SUNY-Fredonia 9-0 ... Thiel will be on the road for a pair of matches this week, traveling to Penn State Behrend on Tuesday (4 p.m.) and Westminster on Wednesday (3:30 p.m.).



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J won both of its matches last week to improve to 6-4 overall and 1-2 in PAC play ... The Presidents dropped two of three doubles contests to open the FSU match, but stormed back to claim five of the six singles contests ... Sophomore Lisa McLaughlin and freshman Kerri DiGiovanni led the way with 2-0 records ... The

duo combined for an 8-1 triumph at No. 3 doubles, then DiGiovanni recorded a 6-3, 6-2 win at No. 5 singles while McLaughlin racked up a 6-1, 6-3 victory at No. 6 ... W&J won two of the three doubles at Thomas More and then split the singles for the league win ... McLaughlin once again picked up two wins at No. 5 singles and teaming with sophomore **Allison Johnston** at No. 1 doubles.



Westminster Titans

The Lady Titan netters dropped their only match of the week with an 8-1 PAC defeat at Bethany Tuesday ... The lone winner for Westminster was freshman **Alyson Lingle** at sixth singles ... The Lady Titans host three home matches this week, as Westminster faces PAC foes Grove City (Monday) and Thiel (Wednesday) before hosting Mount Union Friday ... Only the Thiel match will count in the league standings.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets dropped a 9-0 match against Grove City on Tuesday before rebounding with a 6-3 victory over Penn State-Altoona on Thursday ... In the match against perennial conference champion Grove City, junior **Jenn Knight** forced a first-set tiebreaker at No. 3 singles before falling in straight sets ... Knight was one of four Yel-

low Jacket players to post multiple victories against PS-Altoona ... Knight and doubles partner **Beth Conlon** posted a 9-7 victory at No. 2 doubles before both posted wins in singles play ... Senior team captain **Mindy Hall** and freshman **Laura Garcia** posted an 8-6 win in doubles before recording victories at the No. 1 and No. 4 single positions.
