### *Bethany Bison*

The Bison women's tennis team went 1-1 last week, with both matches being against PAC opponents ... Bethany began the week with a 6-3 loss at home against Westminster in a non-league match, then closed conference play by sweeping Thiel on the road, 9-0 ... **Hillary Norman** went 4-0 for the week, winning no. 2 singles against both teams, and adding two wins at first doubles with teammate **Katie Navarra** ... Navarra added three wins during the week, winning No. 1 singles against Thiel and winning No. 1 doubles in both matches.

### *Wash. & Jeff. Presidents*

Washington & Jefferson had its losing streak extended to five matches this week after falling to Waynesburg and Chatham ... The Presidents were also scheduled to meet Grove City on Tuesday, but the match was postponed due to rain and rescheduled for Oct. 18<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 pm ... Seniors **Jennifer Scott** and **Terra Naviglia** posted the Presidents' lone point in the loss to Westminster with an 8-6 victory at No. 1 doubles ... Led by doubles' wins by Naviglia, Scott and seniors **Katy Petousis** and **Kristina Tarasan**, the Presidents jumped out to a 2-1 lead heading into singles action on Saturday versus Chatham ... However, Chatham claimed four of the six individual matches to earn the win.

### *Grove City Wolverines*

Grove City improved to 5-1 with a non-conference win over PAC foe Westminster Thursday ... **Megan Hulick** and **Julie Crewson** were double-winners for Grove City ... **Kristin McNally**, **Lindsay Hosler**, **Nicole Leasure** and **Jenna Powell** all earned singles wins ... Grove City went 6-0 in singles action ... Grove City's match at Washington and Jefferson Tuesday was postponed due to rain ... The Wolverines are on the road twice this week, visiting Slippery Rock and Allegheny.

### *Waynesburg Yellow Jackets*

After their four-match win streak was snapped by Penn State-Behrend earlier in the week, Waynesburg swept singles play on Thursday against W&J to start a new win streak ... Four Yellow Jackets recorded multiple victories in the 8-1 win over the Presidents ... Sophomore **Beth Conlon** posted a perfect 4-0 record this week ... She teamed with classmate Jenn Knight for doubles wins ... She was the lone Jacket to record multiple victories in each match this week ... Against the Lions, Conlon rallied back to win the match after dropping the first set, while against the Presidents she allowed only two points in her win ... Freshman **Katie Kravits** improved her record to 8-2 at No. 2 singles with wins in both matches and leads the team with nine singles wins.

### *Thiel Tomcats*

Thiel dropped a pair of matches last week, falling at home to Bethany 9-0 on Wednesday and on the road 8-1 to SUNY Fredonia on Thursday ... Freshman **Ashley Crothers** picked up her first victory of the season at SUNY Fredonia, defeating **Ellen Engel** 6-2, 6-2 at number two singles.

### *Westminster Titans*

Westminster went 1-2 last week, posting a non-league 6-03 win at Bethany before dropping non-conference matches at PAC foe Grove City (7-2) and Mount Union (6-3) ... Three Lady Titans were double winners against Bethany ... The senior duo of **Bethany Grubbs** and **Amy Browell** won at #4 and #5 singles, respectively, while teaming to capture #3 doubles ... They were joined by freshman **Christina Commisso**, who won at #6 singles while teaming at #2 doubles with classmate **Dana Larson** ... Grubbs/Browell and Commisso/Larson won at #2 and #3 doubles at GCC, while Browell was again a double winner in the Mount Union loss.
