Bethany Bison

Bethany took a pair of PAC matches last week to improve to 7-4 overall and 4-2 in the PAC ... Against the Lady Cats, two of Bethany's three doubles teams won by 8-0 scores, while in singles, BC lost just four points in six matches ... Beth Wichrowski (#3) and August Gardner (#5) both won by 6-0, 6-0 scores ... In the W&J match, Katie Navarra, Hillary Norman, Wichrowski and Lindsay Caparese were all double winners in the 7-2 triumph ... For the week, all four players went 4-0.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson recorded two wins in its three matches last week, defeating Frostburg State and Chatham, while falling to Bethany in West Virginia ... In the win over Frostburg State, senior Jennifer Lazorchak and juniors Terra Naviglia and Katy Petousis all won both their singles and doubles matches ... Lazrochak picked up the Presidents lone singles win in the loss to the Bison, while Petousis and junior Cassandra Nicastro teamed to win at No. 3 doubles ... Junior Jennifer Scott fought back from one set down in the final match to defeat her opponent at No. 1 singles which earned W&J the win over Chatham.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City closed PAC play with a home sweep of Westminster last Monday, raising the Lady Wolverines' record to 5-0 in completed matches ... All six singles matches were won in straight sets while in doubles action, Grove City lost just two games in three matches ... Against Division II West Liberty State last Wednesday, junior Megan Hulick and freshman Lindsay Hosler were double-winners ... Hosler is 4-0 against Division II foes this year ... Grove City will look to secure its 17th consecutive conference title this weekend in Erie ... Senior Allison Atwood is the defending PAC player of the year and owns a career record of 75-12.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg had its four-match win streak snapped by California last Thursday, 8-1, with the No. 3 doubles tandem of Beth Conlon and Jenn Knight claiming the Jackets' Ione win, 8-3, over Daniella Zevallos and Gina Pelehac ... Conlon and Knight lead the team with 10 doubles match wins this season ... The Jackets posted their third shutout of the year Tuesday beating Thiel, 9-0, for their sixth win in the last seven matches ... The No. 1 doubles team of Andrea Custer and Rebecca Greene won to improve to 7-0; that streak was eventually stopped against Cal U ... Waynesburg steps out of PAC play Tuesday at PSU-Altoona, before gearing up for the PAC Championships this weekend.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat women's tennis team dropped to 0-8 last week after falling to PAC rivals Bethany (0-9) and Waynesburg (0-9) ... The team's match against SUNY-Fredonia was cancelled Thursday due to inclement weather ...
