PAC Women's Tennis Player of the Week

ERIN BENNETT Grove City College

Sophomore - #5 singles/#3 doubles Poland, Ohio/Poland H.S.

Bennett was a perfect 4-0 on the week, leading the Wolverines to three wins over PAC opponents: Westminster (8-1), Bethany (6-3) and Thomas More (9-0). She did not lose a game in singles or doubles action in the conference win at Thomas More.

Also nominated was senior **Erica Smith** of Bethany, sophomore **Lisa McLaughlin** of Washington & Jefferson, and junior **Andrea Pastorius** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany split a pair of matches last week to put their record at 6-8 overall ... The Bison captured a 5-4 decision over W&J Monday ... The Presidents took a two of three doubles matches, but BC responded with four wins in singles play

... The deciding match was at #5, where senior **Erica Smith** took a three-set victory 6-3, 4-6, 6-2 ... Bethany players are 3-0 when matches go to a third set in 2005 ... The win was also highlighted by **Hillary Norman** winning at first doubles and singles ... Bethany then fell 6-3 to Grove City Wednesday ... BC took two of three in doubles, but could only manage one singles triumph ... Smith was the lone player to win twice, as she paired with **August Gardner** for an win at second doubles and then claimed a win at fifth singles.



Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel women's tennis team dropped a pair of road matches last week, falling at Penn State Behrend 9-0 on Tuesday and 9-0 at Westminster on Wednesday ... The Tomcats will conclude their regular season this week with matches at Grove City Monday and at Bethany Thursday.

Sager and Julie Bellissimo won at first singles against Westminster while Ross teamed with Bethany Shaffer for a second doubles victory.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More lost its only match of the week, falling to Grove City, 9-0 ... Junior **Whitney Reis** was the lone TMC

player to record a game win in singles, falling 6-3, 6-0 ... She earned two more in doubles as she teamed with sophomore **Alma Murga**, and fell in first doubles, 8-2.

Bethany claimed four of the six singles matches to earn a 5-4 victory over Washington & Jefferson in women's tennis action on Monday afternoon ... Sophomores Allison Johnston and Lisa McLaughlin picked up the lone Presidents' singles victories ... McLaughlin, who is 3-0 in singles and doubles play over her past three matches,
