The Bison went 0-3 last week and lost two tough matches to W&J and Fairmont State by 5-4 scores ... All three matches last week were at home ... Hillary Norman again led the squad by going 3-0 in second singles competition, along with a 2-1 record at first doubles with partner Katie Navarra ... At third singles, Lindsay Caparese also went 3-0 for the week, while teaming with Erica Smith for a win at second doubles against Fairmont ... The Bison will conclude the regular season this week vs. Grove City on Thursday.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson snapped its fivematch losing streak this past week with victories over Bethany and Frostburg State ... The Presidents claimed the No. 4, 5 and 6 singles matches and No. 2 and 3 doubles contests on Tuesday to defeat the Bison ... Seniors Katy Petousis, Cassandra NiCastro and Kristina Tarasan captured the singles matches, while senior Lauren Latuska and NiCastro won at No. 2 doubles and Petousis and Tarasan claimed the No. 3 doubles match ... The Presidents swept Frostburg State led by a 6-0, 6-0 victory by Petousis at No. 4 singles ... Senior Jennifer Scott also notched a 6-3, 6-1 win at No. 1 singles.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City earned a pair of wins over local rivals Slippery Rock and Allegheny last week, raising Grove City's record to 7-1 ... Kristin McNally, Lindsay Hosler and Nicole Leasure all earned two victories over Division II Slippery Rock ... All three also went 2-0 against Allegheny ... Kelsey Nee went 2-0 at sixth singles while Jenna Powell teamed with Leasure for two wins at third doubles ... The Wolverines host Washington and Jefferson and Waynesburg in back-toback home matches Monday and Tuesday before wrapping up the regular season with matches at Bethany and Washington and Jefferson ... Grove City is going for its first 10-win season since a 12-1 mark in 1999.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg extended its conference win streak to three matches Monday with a 9-0 sweep of Thiel, before dropping consecutive matches to Mt. Union in nonconference play and Westminster ... Junior team captain Mindy Hall posted a 3-0 record at No. 1 singles during the week ... Against Mt. Union Friday, Hall won her singles match in straight sets, both of which were decided by tiebreakers ... She teamed with freshman Katie Kravits at No. 1 doubles for an 8-3 victory over Thiel Monday ... Kravits also posted a perfect 3-0 record in singles play this week and now has a team-best 12 wins in singles play ... Sophomores Beth Conlon and Jenn Knight were the other Jacket netters to record multiple wins in singles play.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel was dealt three losses last week, falling to PAC opponents Waynesburg (0-9) and Westminster (0-9) before losing at home to Penn State Behrend (0-9).

Westminster Titans

Westminster went 2-1 last week, splitting non-league matches with Thiel (W 9-0) and D-II Clarion (L 9-0) before topping Waynesburg 5-4 in the team's PAC regular season finale ... Three Lady Titan netters were double winners against the Yellow Jackets: seniors Bethany Grubbs and Amy Browell won at #4 and #5 singles, respectively, while also teaming for victory at #3 doubles ... They were joined by freshman Christina Commisso, who captured #6 singles while teaming with classmate Dana Larson at #2 doubles ... Senior Amy Caliquiri won at #1 singles and #1 doubles with sophomore Sara Belsito against Thiel, while sophomore Betsy Nolan was also victorious at #5 singles.
