Gans lost only two singles games on the week, while her 9-8 victory at first doubles turned out to be the difference in the match at Clarion. She has now won seven straight singles matches.

NEWS & NOTES: Westminster remained unbeaten at 13-0 following a pair of wins, as sophomore **Caitlin Hosler** was a perfect 4-0 at first singles and doubles ... Bethany was also 2-0 with a pair of tight 5-4 victories, as junior **Maria Vallone** was a perfect 4-0 at first singles and doubles ... After topping D-II Clarion 5-4, Saint Vincent took over sole possession of third place in the PAC with a 9-0 blanking of Thomas More ... Grove City went 2-2 on the week, led by **Reena Barnett** (3-1 at fourth singles, 3-1 at second doubles) ... Geneva also had a busy week, going 1-2, as senior **Kara Zimmerman** posted a pair of wins at first singles ... Thomas More dropped its lone match of the week at Saint Vincent 9-0 ... Thiel was 0-2 despite freshman **Shay Kashey** going 3-1 at second singles and first doubles ... Waynesburg posted a hard-luck 0-3 week with a pair of 5-4 losses, as freshman **Ellen Limback** was 4-2 overall ... W&J fell 9-0 to Grove City in its only action last week ... Chatham was off last week.

Bethany Bison (9-5, 3-4 PAC)

The Bison raised their record to 9-5, the most wins by the program since going 12-2 in 2001, with a pair of narrow victories last week ... Bethany took two of three in doubles to start against Waynesburg and then split singles to earn the win, with the decisive victory coming from **Tara Harris** at #6 singles, who gutted out a 6-1, 7-6 win after suffering an injury late in the second set ... On Saturday, BC celebrated Homecoming with another 5-4 win over La Roche ... Wins by **Maria Vallone** and **Madelyn Coffey** at #1 and **Tinuke Adetunji** and **Brittani Seeman** at #2 doubles started the day and straight set victories from Vallone (#1), Adetunji (#2) and Coffey (#4) secured the victory for the Bison.

GCC highlighted the week with a 9-0 sweep of W&J Friday ... **Reena Barnett**, **Christina Bedi**, **Emily Buurma**, **Caroline McGuire** and **Stacy Moon** all earned two wins each ... **Kaitlyn Heese** made her varsity debut at No. 6 singles and earned a win ... Barnett earned two wins Wednesday against Allegheny ... Saturday against Baldwin-Wallace, Barnett, Bedi, **Megan Bennett** and McGuire all won twice ... **Lauren Troxel** teamed with Bedi for a win at No. 3 doubles ... Bennett and Moon won at first doubles against Oberlin Saturday afternoon ... Grove City concludes the conference schedule this week with road matches at Chatham and Thomas More.



Saint Vincent Bearcats (13-3, 5-2 PAC)

Freshman **Kylie Auman** is 4-0 in singles ... Senior **Emily Morris** and junior **Stephanie Rubin** 10-3 in doubles; Senior **Alexis Cup** and sophomore Amanda Gans have won five-straight No. 1 doubles matches ... Gans is 12-1 overall in singles all at No. 2, and has won seven-straight singles matches ... Freshman **Morgan Dolinar** has posted a 10-3 singles record, including 7-0 in PAC singles and has won four-straight, mainly at the No. 3 position.



Thiel Tomcats (1-14, 0-8 PAC)

The Tomcats were defeated in both of their contests this past week to drop to 1-14 on the season ... In the first contest Thiel was defeated 8-1 by La Roche ... The Tomcats' lone winner was **Shay Kashey** at number two singles as she defeated **Chelsey Wassel** 8-4 ... In the second match, the Tomcats fell 5-4 to Penn State-Altoona ... Kashey once again earned a victory in singles play, defeating **Katelyn Piper** ... She also picked up a victory in number one doubles with Rachael LaBar as they won 8-3 ... LaBar also picked number one singles, winning 6-1, 6-0 over **Alexis Orr** and was joined in singles victory by **Amy Nacey** who took number six singles 6-4, 6-1.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (1-11, 1-7 PAC)

W&J fell to Grove City in its only match last week...Senior **Carrie Campbell** leads the Presidents with five singles victories this season...The combination of Campbell and junior **Danielle Ufolla** have won a team-best six doubles matches ... W&J hosts Geneva this week in its final tune-up before next week's PAC Championship Tournament ... The Presidents lost to the Golden Tornadoes last year by a 7-2 margin.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (3-9, 3-5 PAC)

It was a frustrating week for the Yellow Jackets, who went 0-3 against PAC opponents, including a pair of hard-fought 5-4 defeats ... One highlight of the week was the play of freshman **Ellen Limback**, who went 2-1 in singles action and 2-1 in doubles play for a total record of 4-2 ... Her biggest victory came against PAC-leading Westminster ... Limback bested the Titans' **Lauren Latinovich** 6-7 (3-7), 6-2, 6-4 at fourth singles for the first Waynesburg victory against a Westminster player since 2007.



Westminster Titans (13-0, 9-0 PAC)

Westminster extended its school-record win streak to 13 matches with a pair of wins last week ... The Titans beat Waynesburg, 8-1, at home in a PAC match Wednesday before winning 7-1 at Penn State Behrend Friday ... The Behrend match was called for darkness with No. 6 singles suspended, but Westminster had already clinched the win ... Juniors **Alex Bailey** and **Jane Larson** and sophomore **Caitlin Hosler** each went 4-0 during the week ... Larson won twice at No. 3 singles and at No. 2 doubles with senior **Lauren Latinovich** ... Latinovich became Westminster's all-time leader for career doubles wins with a career record of 51-13, surpassing **April Scudere's** 50-28 mark (2006-09).
