Helfferich and Kerri DiGiovanni, which was the duo's first triumph of the season ... The Bison will conclude their regular season with a match at Westminster Tuesday ... It will also be their final tune-up for the 2006 PAC Championships, which will be Friday and Saturday at the Pennbriar Fitness and Racquet Club in Erie, Pa. ... Last season, Bethany took third place overall, as one singles player reached the championship match and two singles and one doubles team took third place.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City improved to 4-0 in the PAC with a pair of 8-1 wins last week ... Grove City swept all three doubles matches at Westminster Monday ... Nicole Andreini, Erin Bennett, Julie Bellissimo, Lindsey Hosler and Kristin

She earned a 6-4, 6-1 win at No.

1 singles and then teamed with freshman Jessica Garcia to claim an 8-2 doubles triumph ... Garcia also won at No. 3 singles by a 6-0, 6-2 margin, while sophomore Martina Helfferich earned a 4-6, 6-4, 6-1 win at No. 2 singles ... Sophomores Allison Gladish and Samantha Knapek also went undefeated in their two matches.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg College women's tennis team finished its regular season on a fourgame losing streak last week, including conference losses to Grove City and Westminster ... The Yellow Jackets opened the week with a pair of 5-4 losses to Penn State-Altoona and

Muskingum ... Senior Sara DePiano posted a pair of wins in the match against PSU-Altoona, including a three-set victory at No. 4 singles ... Against the Muskies, sophomore Laura Garcia moved up to the No. 1 singles position and posted a 6-3, 6-1 victory to improve to 2-1 at first singles this season ... DePiano moved to third singles and also posted a straight-set victory ... Against the Titans Saturday, senior Jenn Knight posted the only victory for Waynesburg with a 6-2, 6-0 win at first singles.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Lady Bearcats dropped their only match of the week with a 6-3 loss to Division II West Liberty State ... SVC's Lori Orthen, 44 and Marilyn Miller, 49, made national headlines by winning their doubles match against West Liberty State by a score of 8-6 ... Freshman Allie Botti is 5-0

Westminster Titans

Westminster went 1-2 during the week losing its first PAC match of the season against Grove City (8-1) on Monday, Oct. 9, losing a close non-league match to Penn State Behrend (4-5) on Tuesday, and soundly defeating Waynesburg (8-1) in PAC action Friday ... Freshman April Scudere posted the best record during the week for the Titans with a 4-0 mark ... Scudere won at No. 4 singles against Grove City, Behrend and Waynesburg, while also winning at No. 3 doubles with senior Andrea Pastorius against Behrend ... Scudere
