The Bison split their final two matches to finish the regular season 7-9 ... BC lost a 6-3 decision to D-II Fairmont State to begin the week ... Despite the loss, junior **Katie Erdy** teamed with **Alejandra Viveros** for an 8-4 win at second

Grove City set a new program record with its 13th win of the season Friday as Grove City downed W&J ... The Wolverines extended their streak of wins over PAC opponents to 88 ... Sophomores Julie Bellissimo and

Bethany Shaffer each earned two wins against Thiel Monday, as did freshman Kim Ross and senior Jenna Powell ... Powell teamed with Erin Bennett for a win at third doubles against D-II Slippery Rock Tuesday while freshman Chris Sager won at sixth singles ... In Grove City's regular season finale against W&J, the Wolverines dropped just seven games ... Powell, Kristin McNally and Julie Crewson each had 6-0, 6-0 wins in singles play ...
