NEWS & NOTES: Westminster completed a perfect 15-0 season with a 2-0 week, concluding with a 7-2 home win over D-II Edinboro as senior **Lauren Latinovich** was a perfect 4-0 on the week ... Grove City closed the regular season with a pair of 9-0 PAC victories and enters championship weekend in Erie in search of its 25th consecutive PAC title ... Bethany was also a perfect 2-0 on the week, as the Bison were led by junior **Maria Vallone** who went 4-0 combined at first singles and doubles ... Bethany's 11 wins are the most by the program in a season since 2001 (12-2) ... Saint Vincent head coach **Jim Bendel** won his 100th career match when the Bearcats swept Waynesburg 9-0 last week ... **Kara Zimmerman** won a pair of matches for Geneva, who clinched a winning PAC record in their first season of eligibility with an 8-1 win over W&J ... Junior **Alisa Boslett** was a double-winner for Chatham in a 6-2 loss to PAC rival Bethany ... **Amy Nacey** was the lone winner for Thiel at sixth singles in an 8-1 loss to PAC foe Bethany ... The second doubles team of **Carrie Campbell** and **Danielle Ufolla** posted the lone win for W&J in an 8-1 PAC loss to Geneva ... Thomas More closed the season with a 9-0 PAC loss to Grove City, while Waynesburg ended its campaign with a 9-0 defeat to Saint Vincent.

Bethany Bison
(11-5, 4-4 PAC)



The Bison raised their record to 9-5, the most wins by the program since going 12-2 in 2001, with a pair of narrow victories last week ... Bethany took two of three in doubles to start against Waynesburg and then split singles to earn the win, with the decisive victory coming from **Tara Harris** at #6 singles, who gutted out a 6-1, 7-6 win after suffering an injury late in the second set ... On Saturday, BC celebrated Homecoming with another 5-4 win over La Roche ... Wins by **Maria Vallone** and **Madelyn Coffey** at #1 and **Tinuke Adetunji** and **Brittani Seeman** at #2 doubles started the day and straight set victories from Vallone (#1), Adetunji (#2) and Coffey (#4) secured the victory for the Bison.

Chatham Cougars

The Cougars were 0-2 vs. PAC competition last week with losses to Grove City (9-0) and Bethany (6-2) ... Strong performances continued for the Cougars from junior **Alisa Boslett**, junior **Alexa Coughenour** and senior **Leisha Durstine** ... Boslett came out victorious in both of her matches against Bethany College. Boslett won 6-0, 6-0 in the fourth singles spot and 8-1 in the second doubles spot with Durstine ... Boslett has easily been one of the top performers for the Cougars this season.
