

ered the course in 22:26.6 ... Julia Seward took second in 22:35.2 Also in the top 20 were Brigitte Fryan (8th), Kate McRoberts (18th) and Emily Pierce (20th) ... Grove City recorded 49 points while runner-up Gannon had 69 ... On the men's side, Grove City garnered just 21 points in winning the meet crown ... Five Wolverine harriers placed in the top eight, led by overall runner-up Garrett Cichowitz ... Senior Nathan Johnson took third, one spot ahead of senior Dan Spaulding ... Frankie Hourigan grabbed sixth while Gordon Grob placed eighth.

#### Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Saint Vincent men opened the 2008 campaign at the Duquesne University Duals, finishing fifth out of nine teams, trailing only D-I foes Duquesne, Pitt, and Canisius, as well as Carnegie Mellon ... Adam Smith was the top finisher for the Bearcats, taking 18th out of
