

78 and third among Division III competitors with a time of 28:37.4 ... BC's next runner was freshman Clifford Arbogast, who took 42nd, while junior Matt Schlemmer placed 55th overall ... The women's team had three runners place in the top 30 out of a 101runner field ... Freshman Suzanne Stettinius earned 20th place (21:27.6), while freshman Emily Roth crossed in 23rd (21:38.8) and Chantal Stettinius finished 27th (21:51.8).

Grove City Wolverines



Grove City opened 2007 in Cleveland Saturday at the Case Western Reserve Sudeck Classic ... The men placed sixth out of 11 squads while the

women earned fifth in a 14-team field ... For the women, junior Kristen Carter took third overall with a time of 18:53 ... Junior Julia Seward placed 12th (19:58) in her first cross country action since 2005 ... Freshman Garret Cichowitz paced the men's team with a 27th-place finish ... Junior Dan Spaulding took 42nd while classmate Nathan Johnson also landed in the top 50 with a 46th-place effort ... Grove City will compete in the California University of Pennsylvania Invitational Saturday.

Saint Vincent Bearcats



The Bearcat men were led by Adam Smith at the Duquesne Duals, as he finished 9th overall with a time of 26:42 ... Wayne Hooper finished 12th (26:56), while Jim Walsh

took 28th (27:57) ... The only teams to finish ahead of Saint Vincent were Division-I Duquesne University and the University of Pittsburgh ... The Lady Bearcats took fourth place at Westminster's Fisher Invitational ... Laura Magnuson was the top SVC finisher. coming in 7th place overall (20:14) ... Kelsey Sullivan (18th-21:16), Jill Krupey (25th-21:50), and Amanda Connell (28th- 21:52) all finished in the top 30 ... SVC finished ahead of Bethany, Alderson-Broaddus, Westminster, Hiram, Thiel, and Pitt-Bradford.

Thiel Tomcats



Thiel opened its 2007 season at Westminster's Fisher Invitational Saturday morning ... The men's team finished fifth (of nine) with a team score of 143

while the women's squad posted individual times ... Freshman Derek Workman was the Tomcats' top performer, finishing 21st in the eight-kilometer event with a time of 30:32.2 ... Fellow freshmen Alex Bent and Tim Rosario crossed in 20th and 30th place, respectively, with Bent finishing with a time of 31:36.9 and Rosario with a time of 31:38.8 ... Junior Adam Evans finished 31st with a time of 31:40.2 ... Junior Kate DeGeorge was the top performer on the women's side, finishing 55th with a time of 23:28.3 in the five-kilometer event.

teams, while the women notched 11th place of 14 teams ... The W&J men were paced by senior Matthew Rudzki, who placed 20th among a 152-runner field (27:26) ... Junior Bobby Regan finished closely behind in 25th place (27:38), while sophomore Bryan Hanrahan crossed in 96th place (30:11) ... Two-time all-region performer junior Erin Long started her 2007 season with a 25th place finish (20:32) out of 155 runners ... Junior Megan Duffett ran 73rd (21:55), while Crystalyn Lee finished 111th (23:04).

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



Waynesburg opened the season with a fifthplace performance in the 6K race at the Sea Gull Opener Saturday ... Running at Winter

Place Park, the Yellow Jackets had three runners place in the top 20 ... Sophomore Janet Carson led the way with a 12th place finish (24:14) ... Junior Megan Grover finished 15 seconds behind Carson in 24:29 ... Senior Haley Hinds placed 19th (24:42) ... Both Carson and Hinds set personal bests at the annual event ... On the men's side, the Yellow Jackets finished eighth in a nineteam field ... Senior Tim Monaghan led Waynesburg with a time of 30:35 in the 8K race, while junior Shane Gottschalk finished the race in 31:24.

Westminster Titans



The Westminster cross country teams hosted the Fisher Invitational Saturday, Sept. 1 to start the 2007 season ... The Titan men placed fourth out of nine teams, while the Titan women took seventh out of eight teams ... The top finishers from the Titan men were sophomore Jeremiah Patter-

son with a 16th-place time of 29:49.6, senior Will DeLair with a 22nd-place time of 30:34.5 and junior Andrew Brown with a 23rd-place time of 30:36.4 ... The top Titan women's finishers were sophomore Elizabeth Beardsley with a 29th-place finish at 21:53.7, sophomore Amanda Everett in 42nd-place at 22:37.2 and freshman Jasmine Grady in 44th at 22:42.9.
