The Bison began the new year at the Westminster Invitational Saturday ... The women's team placed seventh out of 11 teams, while the men did not have enough runners to field a full team ... Leading the

Not far behind McCort was freshman Emily Andrews in 49th ... Both teams are off this weekend before returning to the trails Sept. 19 at the Penn State Behrend Invitational

#### Chatham Cougars

Chatham finished second in their opening 4K tri-meet at Schenley Park ... Senior Maggie Leathers finished fourth overall, followed closely by teammate Lizz King, who finished sixth in her first collegiate race ... Samantha

Greenwood finished eighth, landing the trio of runners in the top 10 ... The Cougars then traveled to Westminster to compete in a 6K invitational and finished ninth out of 11 teams ... Leathers finished 32<sup>nd</sup> with a time of 26:49, while Greenwood came in at 28:31, an improvement of approximately three minutes from her 2008 6K time.

### Geneva Golden Tornadoes

The cross country team traveled to Westminster on Saturday and turned in a solid performance ... The men's team finished fifth overall and the women took home a sixth place overall finish ... The men GOLDEN TORNADOES were led by Nick Edinger and his 20th place finish



at 28:45 while teammate Owen Struck came across one second later in 21st position ... In the women's race, Shannon Rech was Geneva's top finisher in 19th place with a time of 25:43 in the 6K event ... Teammate Samantha Miller finished 22<sup>nd</sup> just 12 seconds behind Rech ... Earlier in the week, the Golden Tornadoes split a dual meet with Thiel College ... Geneva's men finished just behind the Tomcats, while the women's race was dominated by Geneva College.

#### **Grove City Wolverines**

Grove City opened the 2009 season with solid performances at the California (Pa.) University Invitational ... The women placed five runners in the top 20 en route to the team title ... On the men's side, junior Garrett



Cichowitz won the individual title, helping the Wolverines finish second in the team standings ... Cichowitz won the race in 26:24, posting a 15second margin over second place ... Senior Derek Kruse took sixth while senior Frankie Hourigan placed 11th ... Grove City finished with 51 points ... The women's team won the team title with 54 points ... Freshman Ella Smith took fourth while classmate Sara Fisher finished sixth ... Also for Grove City, junior Emily Pierce (8th), junior Brigitte Fryan (17th) and Mary Kate Breese (19th) finished in the top 20.

#### Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcat men opened up the 2009 season against a tough field at the Duquesne Duals at Pittsburgh's Schenley Park, facing a field with five D-I opponents ... Kevin Wanichko was Saint Vincent's top finisher, taking 33rd with a time of 27:31 ... Teammate Josh Hooke followed closely behind, taking 38th in 27:40, while Ryan Barlow finished 52<sup>nd</sup> (28:16), Matt Hagg 57<sup>th</sup> (28:29), and Adam Tucek 59<sup>th</sup> (28:31) in the 110-runner field ... The Lady Bearcats began the year with a fifthplace showing at the California (Pa.) Invitational Saturday ... Ivette Mejia paced SVC, finishing fifth overall with a time of 19:13, while teammate Emma Goetz also medaled, taking 13th place in 19:50 ... Katie Macioce was SVC's third finisher, as her time of 20:34 was good for 21st overall

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel men won a tight 26-29 dual at Geneva to open the season Tuesday, while the Tomcat women fell to the Golden Tornadoes, 17-42 ... Newcomer Regis Wagner recorded the meet's fastest finish,



closing the 5K course in 17:50 ... Alex Bent came in third (18:15), while Brendan DuLaney (6th/18:33), Richard Peterson (7th/19:16), and Ben Moran (9th/19:34) rounded out the Thiel scorers ... The women were paced by Tiffany Blosser, who compiled a fourth-place time of 24:17... Saturday, Thiel competed in the Westminster Fisher Invitational, with the men finishing third and the women eighth ... Thiel had three men's runners turn in top-25 times ... Wagner led with a third-place time of 27:13.1... Blosser again paced the women in 39th place.
