Freshman **Matthew Schlemmer** was the second Bison to cross, as he placed 28th out of 71 runners ... The women's team, which was seventh out of 12 teams, was paced by senior **Mallory Roadman** in 11th place (25:40.42), while sophomore **Sarah Goho** earned 25th place in the 107-runner field.

On the men's side, Waynesburg placed third in the nine-team field ... Both Yellow Jacket teams posted the best finishes among the four PAC schools in attendance ... The

Colorado native tandem of **Michelle Propst** and **Megan Grover** finishing sixth and seventh, respectively ... Propst ran a time of 24:48:42, just seven seconds better than Grover ... Sophomore **Katie Weko** had a 10th place time of 25:28.16 ... On the men's side, junior **Heath Piper** ran a team-best time of 29:31.36, finishing 10th in the 71-member field ... **Tim Monaghan** finished 25 seconds behind Piper to finish 13th overall.



Westminster Titans

Westminster competed at the Thiel Invitational, with the Titan men finishing fourth out of nine teams and the Lady Titan harriers placing sixth in a 12-team field ... Leading the way for the Titan men was freshman **Aaron Titus**, who placed 14th out of 71 runners in a time of 29:58 ...
