Pedersen captured the individual title at the Allegheny Invitational in Meadville, Pa., on Saturday, posting a time of 23:21 to win by 21 seconds. She also led Grove City to the invitational team title.

Other nominees included freshman **Sarah Goho** of Bethany, freshman **Michelle Propst** of Waynesburg, and senior **Felicie Reid** of Westminster.

#### Grove City Wolverines

The defending PAC champions opened the 2004 season in Cleveland at the Case Western Reserve Bill Sudeck Classic ... **Chris Lee** led the Grove City men with a 15<sup>th</sup>-place finish while sophomore **Andy Leuenberger** took 28<sup>th</sup> ... Three Grove City women finished in the top 35, led by junior **Elisa Pedersen** in eighth ... Sophomore **Cara Pierce** took 22<sup>nd</sup> while freshman **Kylie Mackaness** finished 35<sup>th</sup> ... Grove City will compete in the Allegheny Invitational this weekend.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg women's cross country team featured two runners in the top four to help propel the Yellow Jackets to a third place finish at the Thiel Tomcat Invitational ... Freshman Michelle Propst finished second overall in the invite with a time of 23:27, only 28 seconds behind the overall leader from Geneva ... Following 20 seconds behind Propst and behind another Geneva runner, was Jacket senior Rachel Feldner with a time of 23:58 to finish fourth ... As a team, Waynesburg (73) finished only behind Geneva (26) and Seton Hill (64) on the women's side ... The men's team placed sixth (148) overall ... Heath Piper led the men's team with a time of 28:22, followed by Jack Haines' time of 30:19.

#### Thiel Tomcats

Thiel College hosted the 21-team Thiel Invitational on Saturday ... Geneva College earned both men's (42 pts.) and women's (26 pts.) team titles, while **Jesse Bender** of Point Park (25:46) and **Dawn Sell** of Geneva (23:09) won individual championships ... Freshman **Ashlee Osterberg** led the Tomcat women's team with her 10th place finish (25:07), while junior **Dan Hemme** led the way with for the men's squad with his 28th place finish (30:28).

#### Westminster Titans

Westminster competed at the Thiel Invitational in Greenville ... The Titan men placed third out of 10 teams, while the Lady Titans were fourth in a 12-team field ... Freshman Chris Diamond was the top finisher for the Titan harriers, as he placed 11th in an 80-runner field with a time of 27:11 ...
