

Bethany Bison

Bethany sent full teams to the Waynesburg Invitational Saturday, with the men taking ninth out of 10 teams and the women earning 10th out of 12 ... Bison freshman Cory Yarrington earned his second



straight top 20 finish by taking 18th overall with a time of 27:45.9 ... Two other BC runners had solid outings with freshman Hunter Ankrom placing 44th and junior Joe Douglas crossing in 51st ... The women's team was paced by senior Joanna Mongelluzzo, whose time of 25:13.6 was good for 20th overall ... Senior Desiree Finley also finished in the top half by taking 49th ... Both teams are off next week before returning to the trails Sept. 25 at the Pre-NCAA Mid-East Regional at Coopers Lake.

Chatham Cougars

The Chatham women's cross country team was one of 12 teams to compete in the Waynesburg Invitational on Saturday ... The Cougars finished seventh overall in the 6K race and ahead of three PAC teams ... Each Cougar

set a new personal record in the meet; all first year runners set new personal records from the meet just last week ... FY Rachel Leftwich finished in the top 30 runners with a final time of 25:54 ... Samantha Greenwood finished with an overall time of 27:13, an all -ime personal record for her ... Greenwood also improved her time by over a minute since this race last year ... Lizz King also improved her time this year; King finished Saturday's race with an overall time of 28:54, an improvement of a minute since last year's meet.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes

At Waynesburg, the Geneva men finished third overall behind only first place Carnegie Mellon and second place Grove City ... On the women's side, the Golden Tornadoes finished fifth out of ten GOLDEN TORNADOES schools ... Nick Edinger once again ran a solid



race with a 14th place individual finish with a time of 27:21, over a minute faster than his time on the same course a year ago ... Teammate Jon Shope continued to improve with a 16th place finish in 27:27, the fastest 8K time for any freshman in school history ... Six of the eight Geneva women ran a faster time this week than they did a week ago ... Anayna Merkle led the way with a 14th place finish in a time of 24:53, less than a half second ahead of teammate Shannon Rech in 15th place.

Grove City Wolverines

The Grove City women captured the team title at Waynesburg's 12-team Invitational Saturday at Greene County Airport ... Four GCC runners finished in the top seven ... Sophomore Ella Smith earned third place overall



with a time of 23:30.5 ... Senior Emily Pierce followed in fourth place Senior Kate McRoberts placed sixth and classmate Brigitte Fryan was seventh ... Grove City finished with 37 points ... The men earned second place at Waynesburg with 78 team points ... Garrett Cichowitz led the Wolverines with a fourth-place finish ... Freshmen Arleigh McRae (15th), Alec Schlutz (17th) and Mark Talbott (20th) posted top-20 finishes for the Wolverines ... Rookie Paulson Domasky rounded out the top five for the Wolverines by finishing 22nd.

Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Lady Bearcats posted an impressive showing at the Waynesburg University 6K, taking third place out of 12 teams ... Three individuals earned medals for SVC on the day, led by Ivette Mejia, who finished second overall one week after winning the individual champion-



ship at the California (Pa.) Invitational ... The other two medalists for SVC were both freshman, as Rachael Paszko took eighth overall (24:21) and classmate Genie Fratto 11th (24:41) ... A total of five SVC runners finished in the top 30, as Emma Goetz took 18th and Claudia Arrunategui 28th ... The Lady Bearcats finished second among the eight PAC schools participating, while Mejia was the first PAC runner to cross the finish line.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat cross county program competed in its first invitational of the season at Waynesburg on September 11 ... The meet saw Tomcat junior Richard Peterson earn a fifth-place finish with a time of



26:28.6, while sophomore Regis Wagner crossed the line in tenth place with his time of 27:05.6 ... On the women's side, freshman Emily Petrak continued to pace the Tomcats, crossing in 27th place with a time of 25:44.2, while fellow freshman Valerie White finished 40th with her time of 26:47.7.

Thomas More Saints

The women's team finished 10th at the Queen City Invitational and had three runners finish in the top-60 as sophomore Celia Arlinghaus finished 46th with a school record time of 20:33, sophomore



Alice Wallenhorst placed 54th in 21:08 and sophomore Sarah Miller finished 57th with a time of 21:27 ... The men's team finished 10th also at the Queen City Invitational and had two runners finish in the top-50 as freshman Matt Wurtzler placed 35th with a 5K school record time of 16:28 and freshman Luke Behler finished 50th with a time of 17:39.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Sophomore Scott Ryan set the men's school record for the 8K with a time of 25:57, he placed third in a 112runner field, seven seconds behind medalist Dan Addis of Carnegie Mellon ...
