Geneva Golden Tornadoes

The Geneva cross country teams each had productive weekends ... The Golden Tornadoes took home a pair of second place overall finishes at the Waynesburg Invitational ... The women posted 74 GOLDEN TORNADOES points and the men scored 82 points with each



finishing one spot behind Carnegie Mellon's perfect 15-point performances ... Freshman Shannon Reich finished ninth overall in women's action with a time of 25:35 ... Fellow freshman Samantha Miller was 14th with a mark of 25:57 ... The men's race featured GT Nick Edinger finishing 20th and teammate Ryan Thorn 21st only 3/100 of a second apart ... Owen Struck came over the line three positions later in 24th place ... Geneva will enjoy a weekend off on September 19.

Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Lady Bearcats turned in a strong showing at the Carl Broughton Invitational at Marietta College on Saturday, finishing third out of seven teams ... Three Saint Vincent runners earned medals, led by lvette Mejia's third-place time of 20:13, while Emma Goetz took 11th



(20:53) and Katie Macioce 13th (21:10) ... The team placed a total of five runners in the top 20, as Mejia, Goetz, and Macioce were joined by Natalie Wolff (19th/21:35) and Claudia Arrunategui (20th/22:00) ... As a team, the Lady Bearcats finished ahead of Division I Robert Morris University, as well as D-II schools West Liberty State and Ohio Valley.

Thomas More Saints

Both the Waynesburg men's and women's cross country teams played host at this past Saturday's Waynesburg Invitational ... The Yellow Jacket women earned a third-place finish among the eight teams
