#### Westminster Titans



The Westminster men's and women's cross country teams competed at the Saint Vincent College Cross Country Invitational on Saturday, Sept. 21 ... The Titan men placed sixth out of 12 teams with 202 points, while the Titan women took seventh out of 11 squads with 187 points ... Sophomore
