### **Bethany Bison**

Bethany competed this weekend at the St. Vincent Invitational in Latrobe ... The Bison women placed fifth at the event with 139 points ... Freshman Sarah Goho continuted to lead the squad, finishing ninth out of 85 runners in a time of 21:11 ... Sarah Johnson of Saint Vincent won in a time of 19:43 ... Next for Bethany was junior Mallory Roadman in 13th place in a time of 21:27 ... Tallie Stettinius was 38th in a time of 23:10, while **Dana Culbert** finished In 77th place in a time of 29:07 ... The fifth runner was Callie Chapman in 78th place in 29:25. The Bison women will run at the Pitt-Greensburg Invitational on Saturday.

### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J competed at the Allegheny Classic Saturday ... The men's team placed 15th out of 19 teams, while the W&J women came in 18th place out of 21 squads ... The W&J men posted the top PAC showing in the event ... The President women were the second-best PAC squad ... Freshman Matt Rudzki led the W&J men with a 39th-place finish out of 206 runners ... Rudzki finished the race in 27:56 ... Classmate Preston Lockwood crossed the finish line in 100th place in 29:17 ... Freshman Victoria Caruso set a school record in a 6-K race in 26:29 ... She finished 93rd out of 229 competitors ... Freshman Alyssa Pagano was the next best finisher in 109th place in 27:12 ... W&J returns to action in two weeks at the CMU Invitational in Pittsburgh.

### **Grove City Wolverines**

Grove City traveled across the commonwealth to Bethlehem Saturday ... Junior Elisa Pedersen helped the women's team finish fifth out of nine Division II and III schools with a third-place finish overall in the 66-runner field ... Sophomore Cara Pierce took 22<sup>nd</sup> while Theresa Miller finished 27<sup>th</sup> ... On the men's side, sophomore Andrew Kloes placed 52<sup>nd</sup> while junior Dan Chittick took 71<sup>st</sup> ... The Wolverines are off this weekend and return to action Oct. 9 at Carnegie Mellon.

### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg returned to competition after not participating last weekend due to flooding ... The women's team finished 11th overall in the 21-team field at the 6K Allegheny Classic ... For the third consecutive invitational, Michelle Propst paced the women's team, finishing 11th overall with a time of 23:07 in a field with of over 220 participants ... Her time was 14 seconds better than the previous best time for a PAC runner on the course this season ... Senior Rachel Feldner finished exactly one minute behind Propst at 33rd overall ... Michelle Thompson, Katie Weko, and Haley Hinds all finished in the 26th minute and in the top 100 ... The men's team finished 18th overall ... Heath Piper led the Jackets in 30:36, followed by Jack Haines in 31:45.

### **Thiel Tomcats**

The Thiel College men's and women's cross country teams competed at the Allegheny College Classic on Saturday ... The women's team finished 21st (of 21) with 587 team points while the men's squad finished 19th (of 19) with 599 team points ... Freshman Ashlee Osterberg paced the women's team, finishing 51st overall with a time of 24:57 ... Junior Jill Turrisi finished 130th overall with a time of 29:44 ...
