Both Bison teams ran as individuals at the Pre-Regional meet, which was held at Coopers Lake Campground ... The top finish of the day came from the men's side, where freshman Cory Yarrington fin-

ished the 8K course in 28:04 to place 50th overall out of 198 runners ... Also competing for the BC men Saturday was freshman Hunter Akrom, sophomore Josh Wentz and freshman John Hajny ... The top women's runner for Bethany Saturday was senior Joanna Mongelluzzo, whose time of 26:03 on the 6K course was good enough for 85th place out of 178 competitors ... Three other women's runners had a chance to compete on the same course as this year's regional meet, including junior Kaitlyn Black, senior Emily Roth and sophomore Melissa Davis.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes

After a week away from competition, Geneva had another solid effort at Saint Vincent ... Despite the hardest week of practice, the GTs showed up in a



big way ... The men's team finished second overall GOLDEN TORNADOES with its top five runners finishing in the top 40 ... Nick Edinger was third overall in a time of 27:03, which was nearly a minute faster than he ran on the same course last year ... Other top finishers on the men's side included Jon Shope (16), Ryan Thorn
