For the first time in program history, the Waynesburg women's cross country team had the top three finishes in a race ... Michelle Propst ran away from the pack at the Bobcat Invitational in 17:46 for her first collegiate win, 51 seconds ahead of teammate Rachel Feldner ... Feldner (18:37) and junior Michelle Thompson (19:08) rounded out the top three overall runners in the race ... Katie Weko finished 9th overall in 19:50 ... On the men's side, Waynesburg finished 3rd overall for its highest finish since the program restarted last season ... Heath Piper led all Jacket runners with a time of 28:59 and finished sixth overall, while teammates Trevor Vaughn and Jack Haines finished eighth and ninth, respectively.

Westminster Titans

Westminster placed second and third, respectively, at the Washington & Lee Invitational in Lexington, VA ... Freshman Chris Diamond was the top men's finisher as he placed fifth in a 37-runner field in 30:32 ...
