Pacing the Cougar harriers was FY Rachel Leftwich (third in 26:03) and Tessa Hochberg (fourth in 26:09) ... Thiel also competed at UP-G, with the Tomcat men placing second and the women fourth ... Sophomore Regis Wagner led Thiel with a third-place finish (28:08.4), while Tomcat freshman Valerie White was fifth (26:24) ... Grove City's men's & women's teams placed 36th and 13th, respectively, running against a largely D-I and D-II field at the Lehigh Paul Short Invitational in Bethlehem, Pa. ...
