PAC Men's Cross Country Runner of the Week

Senior Tiffany Baumgart was the next Bison runner to finish, placing 28th overall ... The men's team did not have enough runners to field a complete team ... Sophomore Ken Hopper was the top BC runner, finishing 26th (29:35.8).

Grove City Wolverines

After a one-week hiatus, Grove City returned to action Saturday at the Dickinson Long Course/Short Course Invitational ... Grove City participated in the 8-kilometer Long Course portion of the event ... The women's team took 11th out of 36 teams while the men finished 12th of 36 ... Steve Brown led Grove City men with a 19th-place finish while Dan Adams finished 49th out of 260 ... Nick Gingerich (68th) and Jack Anderson (79th) also finished in the top-third of the field ... On the women's side, sophomore Elisa Pedersen took ninth out of 203 runners while frosh Alex Anderson placed 65th ... The event also featured a 4-kilometer Short Course event ... The results from both events were figured into the final score, thus Grove City was not placed in the final overall standings.

The Waynesburg College men's and women's cross country teams did not compete in the Dickinson Invitational last weekend as scheduled ... Instead, the teams were idle, and will next compete in the Carnegie Mellon Invitational on Oct. 11 at 2 p.m.

The Westminster men's and women's cross country teams placed 17th and tied for 30th, respectively, at the Dickinson College Invitational in Carlisle, Pa., on Saturday ... The Westminster men were led by senior Tim Snyder, who finished 44th in a 260-runner field with an eight-kilometer time of 28:08.51 ... Other top Titan finishers included senior Sean Gallagher, who was 83rd in 28:51.73; and senior John Libert, who finished 88th in 28:56.34 ... For the Westminster women, junior Felicie Reid led the way as the team's top finisher, placing 66th out of 203 runners with a six-kilometer time of 25:53.95 ... Other Westminster women's times included senior Kacie Zbur, who was 163rd in 28:48.17; and freshman JoAnne Johnston, who placed 179th in 30:23.68.
