In the 8.1K men's race, W&J placed fifth of 21 teams led by senior Matthew Rudzki and junior Bobby Regan, who placed sixth (27:14) and seventh (27:18), respectively, among the 144-runner field ... Sophomore Will Seymour led W&J with a 82nd-place finish in a 171-runner, 4K race field ... Junior Erin Long finished sixth in the 6K race (24:37) ... Junior Megan Duffett earned 36th place (26:15) ... Freshman Laura Procario paced the Presidents' 4K team in 121st place (159 total runners).

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

second overall in the eight-team field, just two points behind NCAA D-II Seton Hill, while the men finished fifth ... Fellow seniors Katie Weko and Haley Hinds finished fifth and seventh overall, respectively, while sophomore Janet Carson and junior Megan Grover also posted top-15 times ... Senior Tim Monaghan led the men with a time of 31:03.0 and 11th place overall (second among non-scholarship runners).
