Monaghan was the top finisher for the Yellow Jackets, who captured the team champion-



W&J sophomores **Bobby Regan** and **Erin Long** posted the top Presidents' finishes Saturday at the Dickinson Long/Short Course Invitational ... The invitational was designed with two races on both the men's and women's sides ... The men competed in 4K and 8K races, while the women ran 4K and 6K courses ... As a combined team,

the W&J men finished in 9th place out of 13 teams, while the President women competed as individuals ... Regan placed 14th out of 138 competitors with a personal best time of 27:12 in the 8K race ... Freshman **Patrick Thomas** ran his best race of the season after claiming 66th place (28:59) ... Long turned in a strong 11th-place showing to lead the women ... She finished the 6K race in 23:42.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

For the second straight season, the Waynesburg men's & women's cross country teams each captured an invitational title ... Saturday, the Yellow Jackets claimed both titles at the Bobcat Invitational, hosted by

Pitt-Greensburg ... The women won the eight-team race (26 points), while the men topped a seven-team field (64) ... Sophomore **Megan Grover** posted a first-place time of 24:27 to capture her first collegiate race ... Junior **Michelle Propst** and freshman **Janet Carson** took second and fourth, respectively ... The men placed two runners among the top 10 overall ... Junior **Tim Monaghan** placed sixth with a time of 29:09 and was followed by senior **Heath Piper** in 10th place, 29:44 ... Sophomore **Shane Gottschalk** placed 13th in 30:06, and freshman **Andrew Archbold** took 15th.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The SVC Lady Bearcats finished sixth in the long race (6K) at the Dickinson Invitational, despite missing the team's top two runners on the year ... **Kara Shirley** finished 28th overall in a time of 24:21 ... **Rachel Gregory** was the team's top runner in the 4K, timed in 17:06. The

men's team finished 15th at Penn State, competing against several NCAA-I and II schools ... **Adam Smith** was the Bearcats' top runner, covering the 5.2-mile course in 27:30, finishing 79th overall.



Westminster Titans

Westminster's men's and women's teams competed at the Bobcat Invitational hosted by Pitt-Greensburg on Saturday ... The Titan women placed fourth in a nine-team field, while the Titan men finished sixth out of seven teams ... Titan senior **Scott Seserko** paced Westminster's men's team with a time of 29:30, good for seventh place overall in the 65-man field ... Freshman **Elizabeth Beardsley** cracked the top 10 as the Titans' top finisher in the women's race ... Beardsley ran the course in 26:05 to place eighth overall in the

field of 66 runners ... Westminster absorbed 81 points while the Westminster men took on 100 points.
