#### **Bethany Bison**

Bethany competed at the Carnegie Mellon Invitational Saturday ... Senior Joanna Mongelluzzo turned in her best performance of the season ... Her time on the 5K course of 20:17.03 was good

enough for 24th place overall out of 261 runners at the meet ... Of the five PAC schools competing Saturday, she finished third among conference runners behind only a pair from Geneva and was 10th overall among Division III runners at the invitational ... Other runners for the Green & White included senior **Desiree Finley**, who placed 122<sup>nd</sup> overall, junior Kaitlyn Black and sophomore Melissa Davis ... The men's team finished in 19th place out of 22 squads ... Freshman Cory Yarrington was the top runner in 100th place out of 234 runners.

# Chatham Cougars

The Cougars finished 14th out of 24 total teams this weekend at the CMU 5K Invitational without two of their top five runners ... The field was comprised of nine non-Division III teams, including Division I, II, and NAIA teams



Rachel Leftwich was the first Cougar to cross the finish line at 21:18, followed by Tessa Hochberg at 21:48 ... Maggie Leathers, Lizz King, and Shuntia Hamilton rounded out the top five for Chatham ... Hamilton finished with an overall time of 23:56 - an improvement of a minute and a half from last year's race.

#### Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Geneva was back on the course at Carnegie Mellon University ... The women placed eighth overall including victories over all the PAC schools that were competing ... Julia Urbanski and Alayna Merkle GOLDEN TORNADOES each finished in the top 20 for the women ... Merkle



came across the line with the third best freshmen time in a very competitive field ... In men's action, the GTs finished 11th overall with wins overall all PAC schools with the exception of Saint Vincent ... The highlight performance of the day was turned in by Andrew Maienshein ... With a steady improvement each week, Maienshein ran a personal best time of 29:28 at CMU on Saturday ... For the season, a total of nine runners have already qualified for the NCCAA national meet.

The women's squad took ninth out of 25 teams at the Rumble last season while the Wolverine men finished 15th in a 28team Rumble.

#### Saint Vincent Bearcats

The SVC men's and women's teams both fared well Saturday, with the Lady Bearcats finishing fifth out of 22 schools at the DeSales Invitational 6K, and the men taking fifth of 23 teams at Carnegie Mellon ... The Lady Bearcats were led by Ivette Mejia, who took fifth indi-



vidually in a field of 208 runners with a time of 23:18 ... She was the top Division-III finisher in the race, while as a team, the Lady Bearcats had the second highest finish among D-III schools ... The Bearcat men turned in a well-balanced effort, as all seven finishers cracked the 28minute mark and came in the top 70 in the 202 runner field ... Jeff Hite led the way with a 29th place time of 27:03, while Kevin Wanichko took 34th (27:11).

#### **Thiel Tomcats**

The Tomcat cross country program returns to action on Saturday at Oberlin's third-annual Inter-Regional Rumble, being held at the Oberlin College Cross Country Trail ... Saturday's event will be the final tune up for the Tomcats before the PAC Championships on Oct.
