PAC Men's Cross Country Runner of the Week

ANDREW KLOES Grove City College

Sophomore Pittsburgh, Pa./Penn Hills H.S.

Kloes led Grove City by placing 14th out of 159 runners at the Wilmington (Ohio) College Invitational on Friday. Kloes posted an eight-kilometer time of 26:56 to help the Wolverines to a seventh-place team finish.

Also nominated was freshman **Matt Rudzki** of Washington & Jefferson and freshman **Chris Diamond** of Westminster.

PAC Women's Cross Country Runner of the Week

Propst earned PAC Runner of the Week honors for the fourth time this season after winning her third consecutive race, as she broke the tape at the Waynesburg Invitational with a time of 23:51 to win by 32 seconds over a field of 50 runners.

Also nominated was junior **Elisa Pedersen** of Grove City, freshman **Ashlee Osterberg** of Thiel, freshman **Victoria Caruso** of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman **Leanna Stitt** of Westminster.

PAC CROSS COUNTRY NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bethany women's cross country team placed fourth at the Jacket Invitational on Saturday, hosted by Waynesburg College ... Freshman Sarah Goho continued to lead the team with a seventh place finish in a time of 25:49 on the 8K course ... Michelle Propst of Waynesburg won the individual title with a time of 23:51 ... Junior Mallory Roadman was next in 14th place after crossing the finish line in 26:42, while Chantal Stettinius placed 22nd in 27:53 ... Dana Culbert was Bethany's fourth runner and finished in a time of 35:13, good for 47th place ... Close behind her was Callie Chapman, who was 49th place in a time of 36:22.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Washington & Jefferson men's cross country teams placed 16th of 17 teams, while the women's squad raced as individuals at the Gettysburg Invitational on Saturday afternoon ... Elizabethtown won both team titles ... Freshman Victoria Caruso led the women's team with a 15th-place finish out of 177 runners in a time of 23:55 ... Freshman Alyssa Pagano was W&J's next best finisher in 82nd place (26:18) ... Freshman Matt Rudzki paced the Washington & Jefferson men with a 61st place finish out of 180 competitors ... Classmate Preston Lockwood also placed 92nd overall (29:54) ... The Presidents will next compete at the Presidents' Athletic Conference Championship on Saturday, October 30th in Bethany, W.Va.

Grove City Wolverines

Both Grove City teams competed in the Wilmington (Ohio) College Invitational Friday afternoon in their final tuneup for the PAC Championships Oct. 30 ... Sophomore Andrew Kloes led the men's team with a 14th-place finish in the 159-runner field while junior Daniel Chittick took 39th, helping the men's team finish seventh ... On the women's side, junior Elisa Pedersen took second overall, helping Grove City finish fourth in the 14-team field and third among Division III schools ... Sophomore Cara Pierce joined Pedersen in the top 20 with a 16th-place finish while senior Theresa Miller took 30th and sophomore **Alex Anderson** finished 31st out of 131 total runners.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

For an unprecedented third consecutive time in program history, Waynesburg women's cross country won an invitational as a team ... The Yellow Jacket women placed first out of a eight-team field at the fifth-annual Jacket Invitational that included three other PAC schools ... Freshman Michelle Propst again finished first overall for her third consecutive firstplace finish this season ... She finished the race at her home course in 23:51, 32 seconds faster of the second-place runner, teammate Rachel Feldner (24:23), which is 22 seconds faster than the time she won the invitational with last season. Michelle Thompson continues to provide the Jackets with another top five runner, as she finished fifth overall with a time of 25:30.

Thiel Tomcats

Freshman Ashlee Osterberg ran to a third-place finish for Thiel at Saturday's Waynesburg Invitational ... The Thiel women's team finished fifth (of six) with 119 team points while the men's team did not score as a team due to an insufficient number of runners ... Osterberg finished with time of 24:53.6 ... Sophomore Emily Slade finished 31st in 29:31.7 while junior Jill Turrisi was 32nd in 30:13.3 ... Junior Dan Hemme was the men's top finisher, coming 15th with a time of 30:39.0 ... The men's and women's cross country teams will be back in action on Saturday, Oct. 30 when they compete in the Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) Championships at Bethany College.

Westminster Titans

The Titan men captured their second invitational in as many weeks by winning the Waynesburg Invitational, while the Lady Titans placed sixth ... Freshman Chris Diamond led the men, finishing the 10-K course in fourth place in 28:32.0 ... Other top finishers included sophomore Scott Seserko, who finished seventh in 29:36.2; freshman Willie DeLair in eighth place in 29:42.9; senior Brad Zerbe in 10th place in 29:58.5; and senior Marcus Corvino, who placed 11th in 30:14.2 ... For the Lady Titans, freshman Leanna Stitt finished in 17th place out of 50 runners with an 8K time of 27:26.5 ... Among the other finishers included senior Sandy Edmiston in 20th place in 27:50.8.
