Saint Vincent Bearcats

Other top finishers for the Lady Bearcats included Emma Goetz (54th/25:58) and Katie Macioce (80th/26:29)

Thiel Tomcats

Led by freshman Regis Wagner, the Thiel College men's cross country team captured the team title at the 2009 Mercyhurst Invitational, Saturday at Pleasant Ridge Park ... Wagner compiled a second-place



individual time of 28:07.0 as the Tomcat men scored 39 points to pace the field of six teams... Sophomore Brendan Dulaney was Thiel's next finisher, turning in a fifth-place time of 28:16.4...
