Cichowitz captured his third PAC weekly honor this season after finish-

ing in 30th place in a 270-runner field at the Oberlin Inter-Regional Rumble in Oberlin, Ohio. His 8-kilometer time of 25:36 broke his own GCC school record.

The Grove City cross country teams returned to action Saturday with strong performances at Oberlin's Inter-Regional Rumble ... The teams' respective school records both fell over the weekend ... On the women's side, se-



niors Kristen Carter and Julia Seward both broke Janna Sallade's six-year old record for 6K (21:45) ... Carter took third overall with a time of 21:26 while Seward finished fifth in 21:34 ... On the men's side, sophomore Garrett Cichowitz covered the 8K course in 25:36, breaking his own Grove City record of 25:42 ... He took 30th overall ... Senior Dan Spaulding also eclipsed that mark by finishing 33rd in 25:40 ... The men placed 13th out of 30 while the women took seventh in a field of 27 ... Grove City is off in preparation for next week's PAC Championships.

Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcat men ran against a strong field at the Oberlin Inter-regional Rumble, finishing 18th out of 30 teams .. Senior Adam Smith continued his strong season, finishing in a school-record time of 25:20, good for 18th place ... Teammate Kevin Wanichko also entered the
