Pfiel opened his career for the Presidents by going 5-for-7 (.714) in a DH split against Lawrence. He went 2-for-4 with a home run and a triple in a 9-4 loss in the opener, then was 3-for-3 with three runs and an RBI in a 14-2 game two win.

Cunningham fired a nine-inning, complete game shutout for the Titans in his first collegiate start, a 5-0 win over St. Mary's (Md.) College in Homestead, Fla. The southpaw allowed just three hits and no walks while striking out six.

Bethany Bison

The Bison moved over .500 with a sweep of Seton Hill in a doubleheader Saturday ... The Bison came from behind in both wins ... In game one, the Griffins jumped to a 5-0 lead, but Bethany scored all six of its runs in the fourth, fifth and sixth innings to earn the victory ... A four-run sixth decided the game, as **Todd Welsh** and **Ian Dunn** hit back-to-back home runs ... Welsh's was a three-run blast which tied the game, 5-5, and Dunn gave the Bison the lead with a solo shot in the next at bat ... In game two, **Billy Deer** hit a walk-off two-run double with two outs to end the game 2-1 in the fifth inning as darkness fell and rain drenched the field ... The Bison trailed 1-0 entering their half of the inning before Deer's heroics.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J opened its 2004 season by splitting a doubleheader with Lawrence (Wisc.) Sunday at the Gene Cusic Collegiate Classic in Fort Myers, Fla. ... The Presidents dropped game one, 9-4, but fought back to rout Lawrence, 14-2, in the nightcap ... Freshman 3B **Shaun Pfeil** went 2-for-4 with a home run and a triple to lead the Presidents in the opening loss, while freshman 1B **Sam Mann** picked up two hits and one RBI ... The Presidents, who started nine freshmen in the second game, exploded for five runs in the first and third innings and cruised to the 12-run triumph ... Pfeil went 3-for-3 with three runs scored and one RBI, while freshman OF **Colby Giles** was a perfect 4-for-4 with two RBI, two runs scored and a stolen base.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City went 1-3 at the Foothills Classic in Maryville, Tenn. ... Grove City dropped a doubleheader to Maryville before splitting a twinbill with Oberlin ... Sophomores **Ryan Carr** and **Eric Arnesen** combined for a two-hitter in a 2-1 win over Oberlin ... Carr fanned eight while Arnesen earned the win out of the bullpen ... Senior **Jake Cuthbert** scored the game-winner in the bottom of the seventh via **Jerry Ott's** sacrifice fly ... In the nightcap against Oberlin, relievers **Matt Kearney** and **John Jacobs** pitched 3 1-3 hitless innings ... Grove City had just three hits in the loss ... Against Maryville, third baseman **Jonathan Mycyk** cracked a pair of doubles in the opener while **Joel Diller** also doubled.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg's first week back from Florida saw three games postponed ... Tuesday's doubleheader at Muskingum was rescheduled for April 1, while games against Pitt-Greensburg and St. Vincent were also postponed with make-up dates to be determined.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats dropped a 13-0 decision at Marietta College Sunday, their only contest of the week, as **Mike DeMark** threw a no-hitter against the Tomcats ... It was the Pioneers' second no-hitter in as many days ... Senior P **Jarred Floch** fell to 1-1 on the season with the loss, working 3.1 innings and allowing 10 runs (7 earned) on six hits with six walks and a pair of strikeouts ... Thiel has five games on the schedule this week, starting with a single nine-inning game at La Roche College on Tuesday (3 p.m.) ... The Tomcats return home for a pair of non-conference double-headers, starting with Seton Hill College on Saturday (1 p.m.) followed by Pitt-Greensburg on Sunday (1 p.m.).
