Henry was 2-0 on the week for the Bearcats,

allowing just one run on four hits in 11 2/3 innings for an 0.77 ERA. He fired a two-hitter in a 4-1 PAC win over Bethany Monday, taking a no-hitter into the sixth and setting a new SVC seven-inning record with 13 strikeouts. Friday, he earned a relief victory with 4 2/3 scoreless innings and five strikeouts in a 7-5 win over Franciscan.

The Bearcats went 5-2 on a busy week, including 3-1 in


