## **Grove City Wolverines**

Both Grove City teams started the 2004 season last Monday ... On the men's side, junior Alex Intihar tied for sixth at Westminster with a round of 78 while junior **Jeff Mohrman** tied for 10<sup>th</sup> with 79 ... Another junior, Brad Dutton, took seventh at Gannon Friday at Lake Shore Country Club with a round of 77 ... The Wolverines were the lone Division III team in the field ... Grove City shot 326 at both Westminster and Gannon ... Intihar and sophomore Chris Nakis tied for 12th at Mercyhurst Saturday with 81s while Dutton added a round of 82 ... Junior Mary Brown led Grove City's women's team to a second-place finish at the Grove City Invitational last Monday with a 44, good for fourth in the field.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg's men teed off the 2004 season with an eighth-place finish at the Titan Invitational Monday ... The Yellow Jackets shot a combined score of 330 ... Jamie White led the Jackets with a score of 79 (41-38) ... White's score tied for 10th place overall, while Gibson tied for 15th for the event ... Both of Waynesburg's women's golfers cracked the top 10 at the Grove City College Invitational Monday ... The event marked the first action of the 2004 season for Waynesburg, which will again compete as individuals only ... Stefanie Basey started her senior season with a fifthplace finish with a score of 45 ... Waynesburg's other golfer, freshman Bethany Thomas finished in 10th place overall with a 54.

## Thiel Tomcats

On Monday, the Thiel men's golf team finished ninth with a total team score of 337 at Westminster College's Golf Invitational, held at the New Castle Country Club, while the women's golf squad finished third with a team score of 246 at Grove City College Women's Golf Invitational Monday, held at the Grove City Country Club ... Sophomore Lucas Munson led the Tomcats with an 81 (39-42) ... Freshmen Chris Kwolek and Greq Goss each carded an 84... Senior Brett Stedman finished the round with an 88 (39-49) ... At the Grove City Invitational sophomore Julie Stevens led the Tomcats with a 56 ... Senior Kerry Gutherie finished with a 60 while junior Regina Greenly tallied a 61.

## Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The W&J men and women opened their spring schedules this week ... The President men finished fourth out of 12 teams at the Westminster Titan Invitational Monday and fourth of nine teams at the Peter C. Rossin Memorial Collegiate Classic on Saturday ... Junior Bob Waters placed second at Westminster with a round of 75 and eighth on Saturday following a round of 76 ... Junior A.J. Zubaty and freshman Erek Bylinowski also tied for ninth at the Southpointe Golf Club Saturday with rounds of 77 ... Senior Lynne Szarnicki won the Grove City Women's Invitational Monday, firing a nine-hole round of 39 ... Freshman Jamie Seka was the only other President competing and she placed third with a 42.

## Westminster Titans

The Lady Titan golf team captured the four-team Grove City Invitational on Monday with a 205, winning by 14 strokes ... Sophomore Kayla Pursifull fired a teamlow 41 to finish in second place in individual competition ... Other Lady Titan scores included freshmen Sara Bonchosky with 46 and Kelly Spisak with 56 ... The Titan men placed fifth at their invitational on Monday, before placing third at the W&J Invitational Saturday ...
