NEWS & NOTES: Geneva captured the team championship at the Case Western Reserve Invitational with wins over Kalamazoo and host CWRU, with senior Rick Colick averaging 23.5 ppg en route to MVP honors ... Saint Vincent senior G BJ McGill averaged 19.5 ppg and 5.5 apg for 0-2 Saint Vincent at the Otterbein Tournament ... Thomas More had a busy holiday, as the Saints went 1-3 (including a loss at Division I Coastal Carolina) behind 11.8 ppg and 5.5 rpg by senior SG Aaron Miller.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Junior G Andy Timko averaged 11.0 ppg and 4.3 rpg for 2-2 Westminster, which finished second in a pair of holiday tournaments at Transylvania and Bluffton ... The Bison have been off since defeating Frostburg State 75-72 on Dec.



17, which was their sixth victory in a row ... This is the second consecutive year and third time in the last five years BC has started the season with an 8-3 record ... Junior British Alexander is leading the team in scoring (13.1) and rebounding (6.7), while sophomore Nick Wilcox is second in both categories with 12.5 points and 5.4 rebounds and is tied with Alexander for the team-high in blocks (13) ... Wilcox also leads the team in assists (2.8), just ahead of sophomore Reece Mabery (2.4), who is tops on the squad in steals (30) and free throw percentage (78.6).

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (8-3)

Geneva's men posted a pair of victories at the GOLDEN TORNADOES Case Western Reserve

Tournament last week to secure the tournament championship ... With victories over Kalamazoo (84-78) and Case Western (71-64) the Golden Tornadoes improved to 8-3 to start the season ... Richard Colick continued his impressive season by capturing tournament MVP honors ... Colick scored 29 points in the opening round victory and then recorded 18 more points in the championship round ... Teammate David Phillips was named to the All-Tournament team with 11 points in both games and a team best eight rebounds in the championship ... Geneva's 8-3 start is its best start since the 2000-2001 campaign.

## **Grove City** Wolverines (4-6, 1-2 PAC)

Grove City dropped a 70-46 decision at NCAA Division II

Slippery Rock Thursday night in the Wolverines' only action over the holidays ... Grove City's iron-clad defense held The Rock to just 37 percent shooting from the field ... The Rock did collect 21 offensive rebounds and forced 20 GCC turnovers ... C Kris Verderber led the Wolverines with a dozen points ... Grove City had not played SRU since 1983-84 ... The teams had met 77 times previously ... Grove City leads the PAC in scoring defense (61.4), field goal defense (37.9 percent) and foul shooting (74.5 percent) ... The Wolverines will play three games in a five-day span, starting Tuesday with a non-conference tilt at Juniata.

## Saint Vincent **Bearcats** (7-4, 1-1 PAC)

The Bearcats went 0-2 over the holiday break, dropping a pair of games at the Smokey Ballenger Classic hosted by Otterbein, losing 84-76 to the hosts Tuesday and 82-77 to Ohio Wesleyan in Wednesday's consolation game ... Otterbein shot 51 percent from the field, including a 7for-11 mark from the three-point line, while outrebounding SVC 34-30 ... Armani Fountain led the Bearcats with a career-high 15 points, while Dennis Bassich and BJ McGill each had 14 points ... Wednesday, the teams shared 13 ties and 10 lead changes before the Bishops ended the game on a 15-9 run over the final three minutes ... Four players scored in double-figures for SVC, led by 25 from McGill, while Bassich scored 16. Tauvon Pettiford 15, and Fountain 10 ... McGill added seven assists, six rebounds, and four steals.

## Thiel **Tomcats** (6-4, 2-0 PAC)

Thiel played one contest to round out the 2010 portion

of their season as they fell to division two opponent Clarion University 91-62 on December 30th ... This marks the third time the Thiel has fallen to a Division II opponent this season (IUP, Edinboro, Clarion) ... Three Tomcats scored in double figures as sophomore G Blair Rozenblad led the charge with 26 points and eight rebounds ... Sophomore F Aundra Jones posted 14 points and nine boards and senior G Lance Randall added 10 points ...Thiel will get back into PAC play this week as they have three games against PAC opponents.

## Thomas More Saints (6-5, 2-0 PAC)
