O'Keefe averaged 19.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 4.0 assists per game last week, as he led Grove City

to a pair of PAC wins over Thiel (75-68) and Geneva (77-66). He shot 75 percent (15-of-20) from the field in the two victories. O'Keefe posted 16 markers in the Thiel win, then bucketed 22 points on 10-of-12 shooting against the Golden Tornadoes.

Also nominated was freshman G Lance Beckwith of Bethany, sophomore W Daniel McKeehan of Thomas More, sophomore G Brian Felker of Washington & Jefferson, senior G Jason Clark of Waynesburg, and junior F Ryne Murray of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2008-09 - Week 8 Conference Notes

TMC TAKES TOP SPOT: The PAC men's basketball regular season reached the halfway point this week, as the first half of the league schedule concluded Wednesday before the second half started on Saturday ... After four teams were in a four-way tie for the league lead after Wednesday's contests, Thomas More opened up a half-game advantage over Grove City and Westminster following a road win at Bethany Saturday ... PAC road teams were 4-0 on Saturday.

WHO'S HOT: Westminster senior F Ryne Murray averaged 26.0 points and 9.0 rebounds for the 1-1 Titans ... Bethany freshman G Lance Beckwith averaged 25.0 points and 8.0 rebounds for the 1-1 Bison ... Saint Vincent senior G Joey Butler averaged 24.0 ppg in two wins for the Bearcats ... Dave Phillips of Geneva averaged 21.5 ppg for the GTs in a pair of losses to PAC opponents ... Sophomore W Daniel McKeehan averaged 12.5 points and 4.5 rebounds in two PAC contests for 1-1 Thomas More. AROUND THE LEAGUE: Grove City shot a combined 58 percent (53-of-92) from the field in PAC victories over Thiel and Geneva last week ... Thiel snapped a 13-game losing streak when the Tomcats won at Waynesburg 74-54 Saturday, behind 16 points each from Cory Chaffee and Sean Devinney ... Waynesburg senior G Jason Clark bucketed a team-high 18 points in the Yellow Jackets' 74-71 road win at Penn State-Beaver ... Sophomore G Brian Felker of W&J had a double-double (12 pts, 10 rebs.) at Bethany.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (10-8, 4-3 PAC)

After climbing back into a tie for first place in the PAC with an OT win over

W&J, the Bison lost a chance to take over sole possession of the top spot with an 84-67 loss to Thomas More ... Bethany trailed W&J by 13 in the first half, but rallied to force overtime and rode **Lance Beckwith**'s 11 points in the extra session to a 79-68 victory ... Beckwith tallied career-highs of 34 points and 11 rebounds, while **Petre Petkovski** had 13 points ... BC struggled to find a rhythm against Thomas More and lost for the first time in nine home games this season... Beckwith again paced the offense with 16 points, while Petkovski registered his third double-double of the year with 10 points and 10 boards and **Joe Testa** tallied 10 markers.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (15-3)



The Bearcats enjoyed a perfect 2-0 week, winning a pair

of road contests against Thomas More and Westminster ... In Wednesday's 77-62 win at TMC, three SVC starters scored in doubledigits, including Joey Butler (20 points), BJ McGill (14), and Mike Medved (11) ... Medved also grabbed a season-high 14 rebounds for his sixth double-double of the year, while McGill added four steals ... The Bearcat defense held the Saints to a 32.2 percent mark from the floor, including a 1-of-15 showing from behind the arc ... Saturday, the Bearcats earned the season sweep over Westminster with an 82-69 win ... Butler led the way with 28 points and a team-high seven rebounds, while Medved scored 25, going 12-of-16 from the floor ... McGill added 13 points, including three treys, as the Bearcats shot 55 percent from the field.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (11-6, 3-3 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson currently sits in fifth-place in the PAC standings at 3-3, trailing

Chaffee and Sean Devinney keyed a 13-4 run that upped the Tomcat lead to 25 points and put the game out of reach ... Devinney and Chaffee each tossed in a game-high 16 points in the victorious effort ... The duo also paced both teams on the boards with nine apiece... Grove City topped the Tomcats, 75-68, Wednesday... Three Tomcats hit double digit scoring totals, led by Devinney, who poured in 19 ... Nick Sefscik threw in 17 and Chaffee added 15 to round out Thiel's scoring leaders.
