Rozenblad earned his second PAC weekly honor of 2011-12 after notching a pair of double-doubles for the Tomcats, who remained unbeaten and in first place in PAC play. For the week, he averaged 19.5 points and 12.0 rebounds per game, including 20 points and 13 boards in a 68-64 road win at Washington & Jefferson Wednesday. Saturday, despite playing just 23 minutes, Rozenblad again led Thiel with 19 points and 11 caroms in a 98-61 home decision against Westminster.

Also nominated was junior G Reece Mabery of Bethany, senior G Brett Matson of Grove City, senior G Tauvon Pettiford of Saint Vincent, junior SF Phil Feinberg of Thomas More, junior G Zach Bellhy of Washington & Jefferson, freshman F Jacob Fleegle of Waynesburg, and junior G Doug Smith of Westminster.



PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 10 Conference Notes

STRETCH RUN: We are down to the final three weeks of the 2011-12 PAC men's basketball regular season, as the top four teams have seperated from the pack and have all but clinched first round home games in the 2012 PAC Tournament ... Thiel remained unbeaten in league play, while Bethany, Thomas More and Saint Vincent also posted unblemished league marks last week to keep pace with the Tomcats ... Wednesday, Thiel is at Saint Vincent while Bethany is at Thomas More.

NEWS & NOTES: Thomas More junior SF Phil Feinberg averaged a double-double (12.0 ppg, 13.0 rpg) in a pair of PAC wins for the Saints ... W&J junior G Zach Bellhy averaged 27.0 ppg for 0-2 W&J, including a career-best 34 markers in a loss to Thomas More ... Bethany junior G Reece Mabery posted 21 points, six steals, five rebounds and three assists in a Bison win at Geneva ... Saint Vincent senior G Tauvon Pettiford bucketed a season-high 21 points for Saint Vincent in a win at Grove City.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Grove City senior G Brett Matson needs five points and Bethany junior F Nick Wilcox needs 19 to each surpass the career 1,000-point plateau ... Thiel freshman Kamran McKaskill posted a career-high 16 points vs. Westminster ... Geneva's Keynon Jackson posted a 13-point, 10-rebound doubledouble at Waynesburg ... Junior G Doug Smith averaged 17.5 ppg for 1-1 Westminster ... Freshman F Jacob Fleegle averaged 10.0 ppg on the week for 0-2 Waynesburg.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

(17-2, 9-1 PAC)With a 71-54 victory at

Geneva last Wednesday, the Bison improved

to 17-2 overall, marking the ninth straight year BC has won at least 17 games ... Bethany turned 26 GT turnovers into 28 points and shot 56 percent in the second half to pull away for its fourth straight win ... Reece Mabery scored 19 of his game-high 21 in the first half to propel the Bison to a 35-26 lead at the break ... James Barton led the charge in the second half, netting 11 of his 13 after the break ... Other big efforts came from Nick Wilcox with 15 points and seven rebounds; British Alexander, who posted his fifth double-double of the season with 11 points and 10 boards; and Brady Pacific with 11 markers off the bench ... Wilcox grabbed his 500th career rebound in the win (505).

Saint Vincent Bearcats (14-5, 7-3 PAC)

Saint Vincent closed the game on a 19-7 run over the final

seven minutes on Saturday to post the 62-57 win over Grove City in its only game last week ... The win helped to avenge an earlier 58-54 loss to the Wolverines in Latrobe ... With just over five minutes to play in the game, Grove City built its biggest lead of the day before senior G Dennis Bassich connected on backto-back trifectas to cut the deficit to one point and spark the SVC rally ... Senior G Tauvon Pettiford led the Bearcats on the afternoon. posting a season-high 21 points in the win ... Bassich and junior G Chris Klimchock joined him in double figures with 12 and 11 points, respectively.

Washington & Jefferson **Presidents** (6-13, 2-8 PAC)



Freshman Mitch Locher netted a career-high eight points against Thiel ... Locher spearheaded a second-half comeback by drilling back-to-back three-pointers, closing the Tomcat advantage to just two in the final minute ... W&J's potential game-tying shot clanged off the rim with 12 seconds left ... Junior Zach Bellhy led the team with 20 points and six rebounds ... The Presidents committed a season-low six turnovers, the fewest surrendered in 186 games ... Bellhy scored a career-high 34 points against Thomas More on 9-of-14 shooting and 12-of-14 tries from the free throw line ... Freshman Andy Carter added 16 points ... W&J fell despite shooting 48 percent (25of-52) and holding a 32-30 edge on the glass.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (5-14, 4-7 PAC)




Following a 71-54 loss to second place Bethany at GOLDEN TORNADOES home Wednesday, the

Geneva men's team found itself in desperate need of a victory ... The Golden Tornadoes got what they wanted Saturday at Waynesburg with a 70-58 victory over the Yellow Jackets ... Matt Lorello led the scoring with 19 points as he continued to sizzle from the field ... Leading the PAC in field goal percentage, Lorello was 11-of-13 combined from the field in the two games last week ... Keynon Jackson continues to give Geneva a lift as he posted his first double-double of the season with 13 points and 10 rebounds at Waynesburg ... The GTs are 5-14 overall and 4-7 in the PAC, good enough to hold a one-game advantage over a pair of schools for fifth place in the standings with just five conference games remaining.

Thiel **Tomcats** (14-4, 11-0 PAC)

The Tomcats stretched their win streak to seven

games, winning two games in very different fashion as they defeated the Presidents of W&J 68-64 and the Titans of Westminster 98-61 ... The Tomcats found themselves in a fight in the first game of the week vs. W&J ... Blair Rozenblad led four Tomcats in double-figures as he notched 20 points and 13 rebounds ... Chace McKinney (14 pts), Anthony Harvey (10) and Devon Adams (11) were the other Thiel players with 10+ points ... In the second game of the week, Rozenblad once again led the charge with 19 points and 11 rebounds in just 23 minutes, as a season-high six Tomcats reached the 10+ point mark ... Freshmen Kamran McKaskill and Doran Phillips each notched their season high in points as the scored 16 points and 10 points, respectively.



Grove City dropped a pair of home decisions last week, fall-

ing to Thomas More and Saint Vincent ... In a 73-65 setback against Thomas More, senior G Brett Matson had 19 points and nine rebounds while C Kris Verderber had 15 points ... The Wolverines trailed by 16 with five minutes left before mounting one final charge at the Saints ... GCC owned a 39-36 edge on the glass ... Saturday, Grove City led Saint Vincent 50-43 in the second half before the Bearcats rallied for a 62-57 win ... Matson again had 19 points and nine rebounds ... Verderber did not miss a shot in the game, going 6-for-6 from the field and 4-for-4 at the line in a 16-point effort ... J.T. Schwartz had six steals ... The Wolverines are 6-6 away from home but just 1-6 in the GCC Arena ... Grove City visits Geneva tonight before hosting Westminster Saturday.

Thomas More Saints (13-7, 8-3 PAC)



Thomas More went 2-0 last week by defeating

Grove City and Washington & Jefferson both on the road ... Senior C Colt Stafford led three Saints in double-figure scoring as he averaged 15.0 points per game ... Joining him in doublefigure scoring was sophomore SG Cameron Clemons with 12.0 ppg., and junior SF Phil Feinberg with 12.0 ppg., and 13.0 rebounds per game for a double-double ... For the season, Feinberg leads the team in scoring and rebounding as he averages 14.86 ppg., and 8.0 rpg ... Through 20 games, the Saints have a +6.2 scoring margin as they average 76.5 points per game and hold the opposition to 70.3 points per game ... Thomas More is shooting 47.1 percent from the field on 524-of-1,113 shooting from the floor.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (4-16, 1-10 PAC)

sity men's basketball team went 0-2 this past week against Westminster and Geneva ... After dropping a 72-55 decision at Westminster, the Yellow Jackets built a 27-26 halftime lead against the Golden Tornadoes ... However, Geneva connected on 19-of-27 free throw attempts in the second half, while the Jackets made just five-of-six foul shots in the final period to pull away for a 70-58 victory ... Junior PG Ben Altmeyer put up 15 points against Tornadoes and averaged 10.0 points per contest this past week ... Freshman F Jacob Fleegle matched Altmeyer with a 10.0 ppg average, while junior C Kurt Bonnet averaged a team-high 6.5 rebounds per game.
