Bassich averaged 22.5 points, 4.0 rebounds and 3.5 as-

sists while leading the Bearcats to a 2-0 week, which clinched the #2 seed for this week's PAC Tournament. He scored 13 points, including the game-winning three-pointer with 40 seconds left, in a 56-53 home win over Grove City Wednesday. Saturday, Bassich bucketed a career-high 32 points along with seven rebounds and six assists as the Bearcats overcame a 23-point second half deficit to win at Thomas More, 91-87. For the week, he shot 64 percent (7-of-11) from three point-range and 92 percent (12-of-13) from the line.

Also nominated was sophomore G James Barton of Bethany, sophomore F Ladell Trotty of Thiel, junior SG Daniel Whelan of Thomas More, senior G Paul Matthews of Washington & Jefferson, freshman PG Nick Herman of Waynesburg, and freshman G Anthony Thomas of Westminster.



Wednesday, Geneva saw a 14-point second half lead disappear in a 72-69 loss to the Titans ... Rich Colick scored 20 points but it was not enough ... On senior night Saturday, the GTs were again unable to hold on to a halftime lead in an 80-70 loss to Waynesburg ... Drew Santarsiero scored a team-best 16 points in the loss, with seniors Brandon Sopko and Bryce Salomone each chipping in with 11 points.

#### **Grove City** Wolverines (5-20, 2-12 PAC)

Grove City closed the regular season with a pair of setbacks

in PAC play last week ... Wednesday night host Saint Vincent pulled out a 56-53 victory ... Brett Matson led the Wolverines with 15 points, seven rebounds and four assists ... Mike Grist added a dozen points ... The game featured 13 lead changes and 11 ties ... Saturday, Grove City dropped a 66-49 decision to Westminster on Senior Day in the GCC Arena ... Luke Tomaselli led Grove City with 13 points and a career-high 15 rebounds ... Kris Verderber (12) and Steve Battaglia (11) also scored in double figures ... The Wolverines honored seniors Tomaselli and Bryn Moran prior to the game ... Grove City is the No. 7 seed in this week's conference tournament.

#### Saint Vincent Bearcats (18-7, 10-4 PAC)

Saturday in Kentucky, the Bearcats found themselves down 55-38 at halftime, only to outscore the Saints 53-32 over the final 20 minutes, capped off with a BJ McGill basket with 12 seconds left that would prove to be the game winner ... Bassich erupted for a career-high 32 points.

#### Thiel **Tomcats** (18-6, 13-1 PAC)

The Tomcats finished the regular season on a roll as

they defeated Thomas More in Crestview Hills 86-85 to earn their sixth straight win going into conference tournament play ... Sophomore F Ladell Trotty led the way for Thiel as he recorded 21 points on 10-of-11 shooting off the bench ... Sophomore G Blair Rozenblad added his 11th double double of the season as he recorded 15 points and 11 rebounds ... Sophomore F Aundra Jones added 16 points, while senior G Devon Adams and sophomore G Anthony Harvey added 10 points each.

#### Thomas More Saints (12-13, 8-6 PAC)

Thomas More went 0-2 last week as it fell to

Thiel and Saint Vincent in two close games ... The Saints had five players average in doublefigure scoring last week as junior PG Daniel Whelan averaged 17.0 points per game, senior SG Aaron Miller averaged 16.0 ppg, senior SG Brian Muse averaged 15.5 ppg, freshman PG Spencer Berlekamp averaged 13.0 ppg, and junior C Colt Stafford averaged 10.5 ppg. ... Miller led the team on the boards with 7.0 rebounds per game, while Whelan led the team assists with 10 and Muse led the team in blocks with four ... For the season, the Saints are shooting 42.7 percent from the field on 647-of-1,517 shooting ... The Saints are led in scoring by Miller and Stafford, who are averaging 15.5 ppg., and 11.5 ppg., respectively.

W&J closed its regular season with two more wins to extend its win streak to four ... Senior

G Paul Matthews made 16-of-23 free throws Wednesday at Waynesburg to help the Presidents knock off Waynesburg 56-44 ... The Presidents have defeated the Yellow Jackets 14 consecutive times ... Matthews finished with 23 points and nine rebounds, despite only making three field goals ... W&J snapped a six-game losing streak against Bethany and snagged the final PAC Tournament quarterfinal home game with a seven-point win Saturday ... The Presidents shot a sizzling 65 percent in the first half and led 44-26 ... Senior Brian Felker scored 21 points and went over 1,300 for his career.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (6-19, 2-12 PAC)



Waynesburg ended the

2010-11 regular season on a high note this past Saturday at Beaver Falls ... Not only did the Yellow Jackets end a 12-game losing streak with their 80-70 win over Geneva, but they also snapped an eight-game skid to the Golden Tornadoes and put together maybe their best performance of the season with the PAC playoffs looming ... After trailing 35-33 at halftime, Waynesburg enjoyed its best shooting half of the 2010-11 season, shooting 61 percent from the floor (14-of-23) ... Freshman PG Nick Herman had his biggest game as a collegiate player with a season-high 19 points and added six rebounds ... Junior F Lou Galante chipped in 16 points over just 16 minutes off the bench, while junior F Jeff Young recorded 13 points and a team-high eight rebounds ... Galante led all WU scorers with a 13.5 ppg average.

#### Westminster **Titans** (7-18, 3-11 PAC)



Westminster won con-

secutive games for the first time all season last week as the Titans locked up the No. 6 seed in this week's PAC Tournament ... The Titans overcame a 14-point, second-half deficit to beat Geneva, 72-69, at home Wednesday, before sweeping the season series vs. Grove City with a 66-49 road win Saturday ... Freshman G Anthony Thomas led the Titans with 15.0 ppg, including a game-high 21 points to go with a career-high 10 rebounds at Grove City ... He also averaged 6.5 rebounds and a team-high 5.5 assists for the week ... Sophomore G Matt Shiner, who made his third career start at Grove City, bucketed a careerhigh 15 points ... In the win over Geneva, sophomore G Doug Smith led the Titans with a game-high 23 points, followed by freshman G Christian Shea with 14 points.

Grove City clinched those titles in four different conference facilities (Bethany, Thiel, W&J, Grove City) ... Tuesday will be the first postseason meeting between Grove City and Saint Vincent ... Saint Vincent earned a 56-53 win over Grove City last Wednesday night ... All-time, Grove City is 10-6 in the conference tournament since its 2002 inception ... Grove City has played W&J each of the last four seasons in the conference tournament ... No. 7 seeds are 1-4 alltime in the quarterfinal round.





Thiel boasts three players in the top 15 in the PAC in rebounding (Rozenblad - first at 9.6; Aundra Jones - ninth at 6.5; Ladell Trotty - 13th at 5.5) ... Jones and Trotty also rank in the top four in field goal % (Jones .599; Trotty .536).
