PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 1 Conference Notes

OFF AND RUNNING: The 2011-12 PAC men's basketball season is underway, with all nine teams eligible for the PAC title for the first time following Geneva receiving NCAA Division III active membership status this past summer ... The Thiel Tomcats are the preseason favorites to capture the 2011-12 PAC title, as TC edged defending PAC champion Bethany in the coaches preseason poll, followed by Saint Vincent, Thomas More and Geneva in third through fifth place.

NEWS & NOTES: Thomas More captured the Heidelberg Invitational en route to a 3-0 start, led by Tournament MVP Daniel Whelan (17.0 ppg, 2.3 rpg, 3.7 apg) ... The 94 points scored by Grove City in their season-opening win at Penn State-Altoona were the most in a season opener in GCC school history, topping the previous mark (93) set vs. Alliance 45 years ago ... Bethany started 2-0 for the first time since 1985 ... Senior G Dennis Bassich bucketed 21 points in a season-opening home win for Saint Vincent.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: W&J went 2-1 on the week, with the lone loss to NAIA No. 3-ranked Davenport, as freshman G Andy Carter averaged 10.0 ppg ... Thiel senior G Devon Adams averaged 18.5 ppg for 1-1 Thiel and earned All-Tourney honors at Westminster ... Westminster sophomore G Anthony Thomas scored a career-best 26 points in a loss to Otterbein ... Matt Lorello averaged 15.7 ppg last week for 1-2 Geneva ... Senior F Lou Galante averaged 10.7 ppg on the week for 1-2 Waynesburg.

With victories over Allegheny and Baldwin-Wallace last week, the



Bison are off to their first 2-0 start since 1985 ... BC led at Allegheny by two at halftime and blew the game open by outscoring the Gators by 20 after halftime in an 82-60 win ... British Alexander turned in 19 points, 12 rebounds and five blocks and James Barton scored 16 of his 18 in the second half ... Bethany won its sixth home opener in a row by holding off a furious Baldwin-Wallace rally for a 72-65 triumph ... BC's 18-point second half lead disappeared, but the Bison closed the game with a 9-2 run, which started with a three-point play from Brady Pacific with 1:19 to play ... Pacific finished with a team-high 18 points off the bench, while Leslie Addy had 12 and Alexander posted 10 points and 13 boards.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (1-0, 0-0 PAC)

Saint Vincent opened the season with a win for the second-

straight year, downing Penn State-New Kensington, 70-46, at the Robert S. Carey Center ... Senior G Dennis Bassich scored a game-high 21 points, including 17 in the first half, on 8-of-13 shooting in the win ... Sophomore G Isaac Turner added 10 points while classmate Dillon Stith registered posted nine points and a career-high 12 rebounds in the win ... Junior F Armani Fountain collected eight points and eight rebounds while freshman Sean Kett grabbed nine boards in his college debut.



Geneva head coach Jeff Santarsiero sits just one win away from his 250th victory on the GT bench.

Grove City opened the 2011-12 season with three games in

four days on the road ... Wednesday, the Wolverines rolled to a 94-71 win at Penn State Altoona in the season lidlifter ... Fourteen different Wolverines scored in the win, led by senior C Kris Verderber and freshman G J.T. Schwartz with 14 points each ... Grove City led by as many as 33 in the second half ... Friday in Beaver Falls, the Wolverines dropped a 71-64 OT decision to Mount Union ... Freshman Christian Locher tied the game at 62 with a buzzer-beating three-pointer at the end of regulation ... Locher and fellow rookie Mitch Marmelstein led the Wolverines with 10 points each ... Saturday, Grove City held off Pitt-Greensburg, 59-58 ... All-Tournament pick Kris Verderber led GCC with 14 points ... Schwartz and Nate Rambacher each scored 10.

Thiel **Tomcats** (1-1, 0-0 PAC)



Classic hosted by Westminster College over the weekend ... In the first contest, the Tomcats fell to the Crusaders of Capital University 76-56 ... Thiel was led by Devon Adams who had a game-high 19 points ... Thiel took game two of the weekend when they defeated the Cardinals of Otterbein 75-71 ... Adams once again led the way for Thiel as he scored 18 points and added eight assists, and junior Blair Rozenblad, playing in his first contest of the season, added 16 points and six rebounds ... To get the victory, the Tomcats shot nearly 50 percent from the floor and were able to force 16 Otterbein turnovers.

Thomas More Saints (3-0, 0-0 PAC)

Thomas More opened the season last week

with three wins over Earlham, Kent State-Tuscarawas and Heidelberg ... In the win over Heidelberg senior PG Daniel Whelan and senior C Colt Stafford each scored a careerhigh as Whelan had 28 points and Stafford had 23 points ... The Saints had four players averaging in double-figure scoring as Whelan is averaging 17.0 points per game, junior SF Phil **Feinburg** is averaging 14.7 ppg., sophomore PG Spencer Berlekamp is averaging 11.3 ppg., and Stafford is averaging 10.0 ppg ... Junior SF Ethan King leads the team on the boards with 5.5 rebounds per game, while Whelan leads the team in assists with 11 ... Through three games, the Saints have a +30.7 scoring margin (94.7-64.0 ppg) ... Thomas More is shooting 53.6 percent from the field.

Westminster **Titans** (1-2, 0-0 PAC)




Westminster opened
