PAC Men's Basketball Player of the Week

NOLAN LARRY Washington & Jefferson College

6-2 Junior Guard Greensburg, Pa./Greensburg Salem H.S.

Larry scored a team-high 34 points in helping W&J post its first win of the season with a 121-120 double-overtime win over Kenyon on Tuesday in the only game of the week for the Presidents. Larry connected on 9-of-20 shots from the floor (including three three-pointers) and was 13-of-14 from the free throw line. He scored the last four points in the second overtime period for the Presidents to clinch the win. Larry also contributed six assists, five rebounds and two steals to the victory.

Also nominated was junior guard **Mike Mazjun** of Bethany and junior forward **Durrell Hackett** of Thiel

Forward **Keith Schubert** scored 26 and guard **Mike Majzun** added 21 as Bethany erased a six-point halftime deficit and rallied for a three-point triumph at LaRoche (74-71) ... Majzun went 7-11 from the floor and added a team-high seven rebounds and three steals in the victory ... Mazjun was 2-4 from behind the three-point arc, and 5-6 from the charity stripe.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J picked up its first victory of the season last week with a 121-120 double overtime win over Kenyon at the Henry Memorial Center ... The Presidents shot 72 percent (18-of-25) from the floor in racing out to a 51-42 halftime lead ... Five W&J players were in double figures led by junior guard Nolan Larry's 34 points ... Larry connected on 13-of-14 free throw attempts ... Freshman guard Arnell Milton scored several key baskets down the stretch and finished with a career-high 20 points ... sophomore center Tony Franz added 18 markers and 12 rebounds, while senior forward Graig Marx chipped in with 18 points ... freshman guard Aaron Olsham notched 12 points, including three treys.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City's bid to open a season 3-0 for the first time since 1982 was dashed in a three-point loss at Penn State Behrend ... Junior **Andy Vlajkovich** netted high-point honors for the second straight game, scoring 17 points ... Senior **Pat Roberts** scored 15 points and added nine rebounds and two blocks.

Waynesburg was off last week ... The Jackets return home against Pitt-Greensburg on Wednesday, then travel to La Roche on Saturday.

Thiel Tomcats

Although starting 0-4 in 2001, the Tomcats have been involved in a couple close games...Thiel lost their opening game to Texas Lutheran 82-81 on Nov. 16 at the Lutheran Brotherhood Capital Classic and lost to Mount Union 68-66 on Nov. 20 at Rissell-Beeghly Gym...Junior forward **Durrell Hackett** put up 20 points and four assists in Thiel's 86-78 loss to Baldwin-Wallace on Saturday ... Hackett was 7-of-13 from the floor, including 5-of-6 from the three-point stripe.

Westminster Titans

Westminster split a pair of games over the weekend at the Dad's Holiday Classic, hosted by Allegheny College in Meadville ... The Titans dropped a 66-60 decision to Muskingum in the opening round, before topping Alma 84-77 in the consolation game ... Senior F Ryan Oman earned All-Tournament honors after averaging 11.0 points and 8.0 rebounds in the two wins ... Freshman F Pat O'Connor led the Titans against Muskingum with a career-best 18 points (on 8-of-11 shooting) ... Junior G Rick Giordano poured in a career-high 27 points in the Alma win, while sophomore F Andy Podbielski and freshman G Chris Hatch each added 16 markers ... Hatch's scoring total against Alma was a new career-high.
