

HOLIDAY BREAK TIME: The PAC basketball schedule will slow down over the next several weeks during the holiday break, although several teams will still be active with tournament and non-league play ... Thomas More will travel to Westminster for the final conference game of 2008 this Saturday (Dec. 20) ... The PAC conference schedule will re-open with a full slate of contests on Saturday, Jan. 3, 2009 ... The next PAC men's basketball release will be available on Monday, Jan. 5, 2009.

WHO'S HOT: Saint Vincent improved to a perfect 9-0 after winning at PAC rival Waynesburg 79-64 behind five scorers in double figures, led by Billy Bains with 21 points ... At 5-1, Thomas More is off to its best start in 17 years ... Junior G Ryan Courneen recorded a team-high 22 points for Waynesburg in a 79-64 loss to Saint Vincent ... Senior F Wahab Owolabi recorded 19 points and eight rebounds for Washington & Jefferson in a 62-59 loss to Denison.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Geneva snapped its five-game loss streak with a 98-94 overtime win over Bethany, as Bryan Hill's three-pointer sent the game to OT as time expired ... Senior F Bobby Glass of Westminster scored a careerhigh 16 points in a 75-65 loss to Juniata ... Grove City's five-game win streak was snapped by Hiram, 66-56, despite 12 points by Ryan Gibson and 10 points from Andy O'Keefe ... Cory Chafee led Thiel with 16 points in an 89-78 loss at Allegheny.

Bethany Bison (5-4, 1-1 PAC)

In their only action of the week, Bethany fell 98-94 in overtime at Geneva

Saturday ... The Bison had an 84-81 lead with 2.2 seconds to play before the GTs hit a three at the buzzer, then pulled away in the extra session ... The loss snapped BC's sevengame winning streak in overtime dating back to 2004 ... Freshman Lance Beckwith came off the bench to score a game-high 27 points on 10-for-12 shooting, with 21 of those coming in the second half and OT ... Tyler Morando and Joe Testa each had 12 and Petre Petkovski and Dakota Matz scored 10 apiece in the setback ... Testa grabbed a team-leading six rebounds, while Petkovski and Matz each handed out three assists.

Geneva Golden **Tornadoes**

Geneva got exactly what it needed Saturday with GOLDEN TORNADOES a thrilling 98-94 overtime

victory over defending PAC champion Bethany ... The Golden Tornadoes snapped their fivegame loss streak in the final game before the Christmas holiday ... Trailing by three with 2.2 seconds remaining in regulation, the GTs launched a length of the floor pass that was received by Richard Colick, who quickly found Bryan Hill for an off-balanced three pointer that sent the game into extra time ... Geneva outscored Bethany 14-10 in the extra session ... Justin Nardi led the way with 21 points, while brother Emilio Nardi scored 15 points off the bench ... Geneva will enjoy 15 days off before getting back into action at the Defiance College tournament on December 28-29.

Grove City Wolverines (5-2, 2-0 PAC)

Grove City's five-game win streak came to an end Wednes-

day night with a 66-56 setback against visiting Hiram ... Grove City held the Terriers to just 36 percent shooting from the field ... However, the Wolverines surrendered 17 offensive rebounds to Hiram ... Ryan Gibson led Grove City with 12 points while Andy O'Keefe added 10 ... Each of the previous three meetings between the teams had gone to overtime ... Hiram has won three straight against the Wolverines ... Grove City is off until December 30, when the Wolverines trek to Bluffton, Ohio for the McDonald's of Bluffton Tournament ... The Wolverines will face Ohio State-Lima in the semifinals ... It will be the first-ever meeting between the teams.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (9-0)

The Bearcats continued their torrid start to the season, im-

proving to 9-0 with a 79-64 win at Waynesburg on Saturday ... After trailing for the first 10 minutes of play, SVC embarked on a 23-2 run to take a 40-25 lead into halftime ... Five players scored in double figures for Saint Vincent, led by Billy Bains' 21 points. Joey Butler added 18, Mike Watkins 14, and Mike Medved and Tre'sor Kalambay 10 points each ... SVC's defense was strong throughout, forcing 27 turnovers and picking up 15 steals, led by Kalambay's five ... The 9-0 start is the team's best since the 2002-03 squad opened the year winning 11 straight.

Thiel **Tomcats** (1-7, 0-2 PAC)

Thiel dropped a non-conference decision at Allegheny in

men's basketball action, 89-78, at the Wise Center last Tuesday ... Thiel fell to 1-7 with the setback, while the Gators evened their record at 4-4 ... Allegheny held a narrow 35-31 advantage in rebounds, but shot over 56 percent from the floor to overcome the Tomcats ... Thiel, which trailed by only four at the half, shot at a respectable 44.6 percent on the night ... Five Tomcats scored 10 points or more in the loss, led by Cory Chaffee, who fired in 16. Freshman Roddy Fuller poured in 15, while Keebo Dowe pulled down eight boards to lead Thiel ... Thiel is off until Dec. 29, when it participates in a tournament at Wooster College.

Thomas More Saints (5-1, 2-0 PAC)

Thomas More is off to its best start in over 17

years as it has opened the season with a 5-1 overall record, including 2-0 in the PAC ... Through the Saints' first six games, they are 5-0 when they hold the opposition to 71 points or less and are 0-1 when the opponent scores more then 71 ... Junior W Daniel McKeehan leads the team in scoring (12.3 ppg.) and rebounding (5.5 rpg.) through the first six games ... Sophomore PG Kurt Bovard leads the team in assist with 14, while junior guard Romell Salone leads the team in steals with 10.

Washington & Jefferson **Presidents** (5-4, 0-1 PAC)



The Washington & Jefferson men's basketball program dropped a non-conference

contest against Denison on Saturday afternoon, 62-59 ... Senior F Wahab Owolabi paced the Presidents with 19 points and 8 rebounds in the loss ... Senior C Josip Lucic-Jozak, who is fourth in the PAC in rebound (7.3 rpg), also ranks 10th in the conference in scoring, averaging 12.9 points a game ... The Presidents return to action this week for two non-conference games, hosting Muskingum on Wednesday evening at 7 p.m. and traveling to Juniata on Saturday for a 2 p.m. contest.
