PAC Men's Soccer Player of the Week

TODD FISHER Westminster College Senior forward Grove City, Pa./Grove City H.S.

Fisher posted two goals and an assist for the Titans, as Westminster went 2-1 on the week including PAC wins over Waynesburg (3-0) and at Thiel (2-0). He posted a goal and an assist in the win over the Yellow Jackets, then scored the game-winning goal in the 75th minute against the Tomcats.

Other nominees included senior MF Jimmy Hershner of Bethany, sophomore F Adam Ludwig of Grove City, and freshman MF Colin Sears of Thiel.

Bethany Bison

The Bison finally got their first win of the season Saturday with a 5-0 shutout of Waynesburg on Homecoming ... Bethany jumped ahead with three goals in the first half and iced the victory with a pair in the second half ... Midfielder Jimmy Hershner and forward Ryan Fiano each scored two goals, while midfielder Lavel Williams tallied his third goal of the season ... For the freshman Fiano, it was the first two goals of his collegiate career ... Hershner assisted on Fiano's first tally, while Dave Weibe assisted on Fiano's second score ... In the Geneva loss, Williams scored to tie the game 1-1 in the 10th minute, but the Golden Tornadoes scored three unanswered for the win.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson had its losing streak extended to three matches following a pair of non-conference losses this past week ... Five of the six W&J losses in 2003 have come by one goal or less ... LaR oche jumped out to a quick 1-0 lead on Wednesday evening before the Presidents tied the game on a goal by senior midfielder Matthew Pihlblad in the 23rd minute ... Sophomore defender Andrew Enrietti assisted on the goal ... La Roche scored a goal; however, with two minutes left in the first half to earn the win ... FSU scored 24 minutes into the first half on Saturday and that proved all that the Bobcats would need in the shutout ... Junior goalie Mike Garet took the loss for W&J despite making seven saves.

Grove City Wolverines

Defending national champion Messiah ended Grove City's five-match win streak Saturday ... The Wolverines had extended the streak to five with a comeback win at Behrend ... Nathaniel Jones tied the match at 1-1 in the second half while fellow sophomore Adam Ludwig scored the game-winner in the final seconds of overtime ... Jones is tied with Bob McNees for the team lead with 14 points while Ludwig is third with seven points ... Grove City opens the second half of the conference schedule Tuesday at home against Westminster ... Grove City won the first meeting between the teams, 1-0, September 24 as McNees scored the lone goal

... Grove City is 5-1-1 away from home this year.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg didn't score in its two road PAC games this week losing to Westminster (3-0) and Bethany (5-0) ... The Jackets have now lost three straight, all to PAC teams on the road while being outscored 13-1 ... Westminster outshot the Jackets 17-6 as senior GK Justin Fee made 13 saves and freshman MF David Thorn led the team with two shots ... Fee had six saves against Bethany, while no Jackets registered multiple shots ... Jimmy Hershner and Ryan Fiano each netted two goals in the victory for the Bison.

Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel men's soccer team dropped a pair of games last week, losing to non-conference Muskingum College 7-1 on Tuesday and falling to Westminster 2-0 Sunday afternoon ... The Muskies led just 2-1 at half time, but scored five unanswered in the second period ... Freshman Steve Haylett put the Tomcats up 1-0 in the second minute of play before Muskingum added six unanswered goals ... Haylett's goal was his seventh of the season, tying him with Joca Esteves for the single-season record ... In the Tomcats' 2-0 loss to Westminster, senior GK David Visnicky posted a career-high 18 saves ... The Titans outshot the Tomcats 33-7 in the contest.

Westminster Titans

The Titans were 2-1 last week, sandwiching PAC shutout wins vs. Waynesburg (3-0 on Wednesday) and Thiel (2-0 on Sunday) around a 2-1 non-conference loss at Penn State-Altoona Friday night ... After a scoreless first half, Titan senior Todd Fisher and freshmen Blake Ordell and Mike McBride scored against Waynesburg, with Fisher, Ordell and senior Nick White adding assists ... White had the lone goal for the Titans in the loss at Altoona ... At Thiel, Fisher put the Titans up 1-0 with a goal in the 75th minute before Westminster added a Thiel "own goal" in the 82nd minute ... Senior GK Kevin Humberston made four saves in the shutout of Waynesburg and five saves in the win over the Tomcats ... The Titans have won three of their last four contests
