Bethany Bison

Bethany had their PAC match against Waynesburg postponed last week and moved to Monday, April 3 ... BC only took the courts once, which was in an exhibition match against Franciscan, who won the match 8-1 ... The con-

test was closer than the score indicated, as two of the singles matches went to a third-set ... Senior **Brian Cerullo** claimed the lone win for the Bison with a 6-4, 4-6, 6-4 win at #3 ... Junior **Robert Lowe** saw his match extend to three sets at #6 before he fell 3-6, 6-4, 2-6 ... Bethany hosts three matches this week, including a rematch with Pitt-Greensburg of their March 14 match that BC won 6-3 ... The week concludes with matches against Frostburg State Thursday and a PAC tilt with Thomas More Saturday.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City improved to 2-0 in the PAC with an 8-1 win at Westminster Thursday afternoon ... Brent Moon, John Moyer, Jeremy Dwyer and Kyle Johnson all earned a pair of victories in the win ... The victory is the 299th ten-

nis coaching win for 34th-year head coach **Joe Walters** ... He has a 288-111 record as men's tennis coach at Grove City ... In 2004, he directed the women's team to an 11-1 record ... Monday's home opener with Thiel will be Walters' 400th match as head men's tennis coach at Grove City ... Moyer has not dropped a game in singles action this season.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats registered an 8-1 non-conference victory at Pitt-Greensburg Friday in their only action of the week ... Thiel had four players win twice Friday, led by junior **Keith Williams**, who earned a 6-2, 6-2 win over **Sam Tharakan** at second singles and teamed with senior **Brian**

Gowday to win 8-0 at first doubles over **Andy Laddson** and **Pat Smith** ... Gowday also posted a 6-0, 6-0 win at sixth singles over the Bobcats' **Matt Blinky** ... Junior **Geno Bianco** also won both his doubles and singles match, working with freshman **Tyler Ochs** to pick up an 8-5 win at second doubles over **John White** and **Matt Marsella** while defeating **Adam Dearborn** 6-2, 6-1 at third singles.



Thomas More Saints

Needing to win all three doubles matches, the Thomas More Saints came up short falling in a tie break on
