Bethany Bison

The Bison snapped a 26-match losing streak with their 8-1 victory over Pitt-Greensburg Monday ... Bethany claimed every singles match and two out of the three doubles matches to earn the victory ... **Brian Cerullo** won both his single and double match, the only Bison to record such a feat against UP-G ... The Bison dropped their third match of the season to PAC competition Tuesday, losing a home contest to W&J ... **John McLane's** racquet gave Bethany its only win on the day ... Notre Dame became Bethany's second victim in a week ... The Bison won four of six singles matches while **Tyler Kowcheck** and No. 1 seed **Pat Greene** notched the lone doubles victory to post the team win.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Washington & Jefferson men's tennis team started its Presidents' Athletic Conference schedule on Tuesday afternoon and captured its first victory of 2005 after defeating Bethany, 8-1 ... The Presidents were led by junior **Gary Tan**, who recorded a 6-0, 6-1 victory at No. 1 singles ... Tan also teamed with freshman **Tim Wagner** to notch an 8-3 victory at No. 1 doubles ... Junior **Ali Nemazee** also recorded a 6-0, 6-0 victory at No. 2 singles ... The Presidents were also scheduled to play Marietta, Penn State-Altoona and Frostburg State this week, but all three matches were cancelled due to inclement weather.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City swept Thiel in the Wolverines' lone match last week ... The Wolverines did not drop a set in the six singles matches ... **Brent Moon, Brock Thompson, Chris Baker, Phil Springirth** and **Sam Fortna** all recorded a pair of wins ... Grove City's home match with Westminster Saturday was moved to Monday afternoon due to the weather ... Grove City is scheduled to play three PAC matches this week, including trips to Washington & Jefferson and Waynesburg.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets continued their winning ways Thursday when they defeated Frostburg State, 8-1 ... The win marked the fourth straight for Waynesburg to even its overall record to 5-5 ... The Yellow Jackets swept singles action in a match for the third straight time when they defeated the Bobcats with only one singles match required three sets ... Sophomore **Matt Otis** earned his team-best sixth singles victory of the spring at No. 1 singles ... The doubles team of **Ryan Floyd** and **Nate Smucker**, both seniors, each recorded multiple victories for the fourth straight match, all Yellow Jacket victories ... The tandem of Floyd and Smucker earned an 8-0 win against FSU in the No. 3 doubles match and now boast a 6-2 record on the season in doubles action.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats, playing host to a pair of PAC rivals last week, finished 1-1 ... They earned a 5-4 win over Westminster Tuesday before losing 9-0 to defending conference champion Grove City Wednesday ... Thiel's losing streak against Westminster had spanned 64 years before the win on Tuesday ... The Tomcats last defeated Westminster in 1940, downing the Titans 7-0 and 8-1 that season ... Thiel picked up wins in the top two doubles spots, with juniors **Brian Gowday** and **Dennis Wright** winning 9-7 at number one doubles and sophomores **Keith Williams** and **Geno Bianco** winning 8-5 at second doubles...Gowday won at number one singles while Williams earned a win at second singles.

Westminster Titans

Westminster dropped its 2005 PAC opener Tuesday in Greenville, as the Titans netters suffered a 5-4 setback at Thiel College ... The two teams evenly split six singles matches, but the Tomcats captured two of three doubles contests to earn the league victory ... For Westminster, junior **Ben Libert** and freshman **Gene Cunningham** posted wins at #3 and #5 singles, respectively, while also teaming to capture #3 doubles ... Junior **Ryan Mistovich** captured #6 singles as well.
