JANICE MASTERS

Bethany College Junior Third Baseman Lansing, Ohio/Bellaire St. John's H.S.

Masters led Bethany to a 7-2 record on their spring break trip by hitting .423 (11-of-26) with three homers, three doubles, seven runs and 16 RBIs. She belted a pair of grand slams and added a third homer in the opening three games of the East Coast Classic.

Also nominated was sophomore OF Melissa Witzberger of Washington & Jefferson and senior P Darcy Sutton of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

After a slow start to the year, the Bison went 7-2 last week ... P Rachael Schafer tossed two shutouts, a two-hitter against Oshkosh and a one-hitter against Geneseo ... P Romney Waters also recorded her first colegiate victory with a one-hit blanking of Benedictine ... The BC bats exploded in Salem, pounding out 27 hits in the wins over Bridgewater and N.C. Wesleyan ... 3B Janice Masters led the way, as her grand slam put the Geneseo win away and she came back with another grand slam against Wesleyan ... The slams were sandwiched around another homer in the Bridgewater win, as Masters went 5--for-12 in Salem with three homers, five runs scored and 12 RBIs.

Washington & Jefferson will look for its first victory of 2003 on Wednesday in a doubleheader at Seton Hill ... W&J also plays at La Roche and at home versus Pitt-Greensburg this week ...
