PAC SOFTBALL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTER Mindy Hall Waynesburg College Sophomore OF Mount Pleasant, Pa./ Mount Pleasant H.S.

PITCHER **Romney Waters** Bethany College Sophomore Burgettstown, Pa./ Burgettstown H.S.

Hall hit .545 (6-of-11) in four games for the Yellow Jackets last week with a double, two runs scored and three RBIs. She went 5-for-7 in a PAC doubleheader w/Thiel.

Waters posted a 3-1 record last week for the Bison, including clinching the top seed and hosting rights for the PAC Tournament with a one-hit shutout of Westminster. For the week, she allowed one earned run (four total) on 15 hits with three walks and 19 strikeouts.

Bethany Bison

The Bison won the PAC regular season title after sweeping Westminster on Saturday, and will host the PAC Tournament this weekend on Friday, April 30 and Saturday, May 1 ... Romney Waters pitched a one-hitter against the Titans in game one on Saturday in a 1-0 victory ... Amy Stoner drove in Heather Bainey with a single for the game's only run ... For the week, Waters went 3-1 and allowed just one earned run in 26 innings pitched ... Angie DeSantis went 2-1 in three starts ... At the plate, the Bison were led by Stoner (.455), Emily Patton (.381) Leslie Lopez (.381) and Waters (.357) ... Janice Masters also contributed eight RBI's for the week, along with four doubles ... Patton and Lopez each scored six runs.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J started the week with a doubleheader thrashing of Chatham, but was swept by Muskingum and Grove City to close the week ... In the first game vs. Chatham, W&J scored all 11 runs in the bottom of the first on just one hit ... Freshman P Michelle Galluze earned her fourth win of the season after allowing four baserunners ... Freshman DP Amy Fallon had two RBI and scored two runs ... Freshman P Caryn Becker improved to 5-0 after a three-hit shutout in game two ... Sophomore CF Jayann Freidhoff was 3-for-3 with two RBI and two runs ... Senior P Lauren Pieri was the tough luck loser vs. tenth-ranked Muskingum Thursday after allowing just one run on five hits ... The Presidents were held to only five hits in 14 innings versus Grove City.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City clinched the second seed in this week's PAC Tournament by sweeping Washington and Jefferson Saturday ... Allison Atwood and Jes Flick both tossed shutouts against the Presidents ... In the nightcap at Washington and Jefferson, Atwood went 3-for-4 with a homer and 5 RBI while Paula Rice and Lauren Carlson both had two-hit efforts ... Rachel Romance doubled twice in Saturday's opener ... Grove City scored a season-high 10 runs against Penn State Altoona Thursday as Atwood, Carlson and Romance all had multi-hit games ... Flick took a shutout into the seventh Monday at Penn State Altoona ... Atwood had a win and a save in the doubleheader at Altoona.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg went 1-3 during the week, including two non-conference losses to perennial Division II power California (Pa.) ... The Jackets lone win of the week came on Saturday when the team hosted a doubleheader split with Thiel ... Waynesburg lost the first game to Thiel, 6-5, which was its ninth-straight one-run conference game ... During that streak, the Jacket lost eight games ... In the second game, Waynesburg broke out of the mold and won decisively, 9-0, thanks to a five-hit complete-game shutout by junior pitcher Shana D'Aurora, who had three walks and three strikeouts ... Mindy Hall, Nicole January, and Kristen Hemingway had three hits apiece in the win, while each player had at least one RBI and one run scored.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel finished the week 3-4, splitting a PAC doubleheader at Waynesburg Saturday ... The Tomcats handed the Lady Yellow Jackets a 6-5 defeat in game one but were routed 9-0 in six innings in the nightcap ... On Friday Thiel swept a DH at Penn State Behrend 2-0 and 2-1 ... Senior P Jen Troyan threw a complete game shutout in the game one of the PS-B series, allowing just three hits in the outing ... Junior 2B Tina Cale led the way in Thiel's 6-5 win over Waynesburg, finishing with a double and three RBIs ... Sophomore OF Katie Walker and junior OF Julie Deloe each had a pair of hits in the win ... Walker, who has a schoolrecord 24 steals this season, is 13th in Division III in stolen bases per game.

Westminster Titans

The Lady Titans posted a 2-4 week (1-3 vs. PAC) to drop to the third seed for ths week's PAC Tournament ... Westminster split with Grove City, falling 2-0 before posting a 9-0 win ... Tracy Tonkavitch fired a four-hit shutout (the first of her career) in the GCC nightcap, while Jennifer Pancake was 2-for-3 with two RBIs ... Westminster split a non-league pair at La Roche, falling 5-4 before winning 10-1 in game two ... Abby Mazar was 3-for-3 with a triple and a run scored in the opener, while Pancake smacked a home run and Katie Parfitt improved to 6-1 with the pitching win in game two ... In a showdown with league leader Bethany, Westminster suffered 1-0 and 6-3 setbacks ... Julie Zappa was 2-for-3 with a double in game two.
