PAC SOFTBALL 2010 - Week 9 Conference Notes

2010 PAC TOURNAMENT: Bethany earned the No. 1 seed and hosting rights for the 2010 PAC Softball Tournament, scheduled for Friday-Saturday, May 7-8 ... The Bison entered the Saturday one game behind Thomas More; a sweep of W&J, coupled with a split between TMC and Westminster solidified the seeding ... Bethany faces #4 seed Thiel on Friday, while #3 Titans and #2 Saints square off ... Tournament winner earns the PAC's automatic bid to the NCAA Division III playoffs, which start May 10.

NEWS & NOTES: Geneva's wins against Waynesburg put the GTs one step closer to an at-large bid to the NCCAA National Tournament in West Palm Beach, Fla. next week; two victories against Thiel today would help the cause as well ... Saint Vincent's Shauna Hetrick finished the season with a school-record 125 strikeouts ... While missing the PAC tournament, 2010 marked Chatham's first season with wins over W&J, Thiel and Geneva since entering the PAC.

PAC SOFTBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (29-11, 11-3 PAC)

Bethany completed the regular season by sweeping twinbills over Thomas More, Thiel and W&J to clinch the #1 seed and hosting rights to the 2010 PAC Tournament ... Their 2nd win over W&J was also the 600th career victory for head coach **Jan Forsty**, making her the 15th coach in Division III history to reach that milestone ... **Emily Jump** threw a 5-hit shutout and **Courtney Newland** gave up 1 run in inn. to pace BC to 7-0 and 8-1 wins over Thomas More ... **Ashley Marinacci** drove in four and **Andrea Thomas** had three RBIs in the Bison's 8-2 and 5-4 sweep over Thiel ... Jump and Newland both threw complete game 5-hitters in 3-1 and 7-1 wins over W&J, while **Maria Vallone** was 4-for-5 with 3 RBIs in the game two victory.



Chatham Cougars (7-25, 2-12 PAC)

Tiffani Jagielski registered the loss for Chatham in the first match-up against Westminster ... She pitched two of the five innings with one strike out, two base on balls, seven hits, and nine runs ... The second match-up against Westminster lasted only five innings as well and the final score was again 13-0 ... Against SVC, **Allison Taverna** led the team in hits in the Cougars' first game with two ... In the second game of the afternoon, Chatham held a 7-1 lead after four innings ... St. Vincent would come back to beat the Cougars by a final score of 8-7 in the bottom of the eighth inning ... **Natalie Vazquez** led Chatham with two hits (both were triples) ... They were edged out for the PAC championships this season, but not before beating W&J, Thiel and Geneva for the first time since entering the PAC.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes (22-16)



Geneva's softball team took a pair of must-win games from Waynesburg on Saturday to set up the final day of the regular season on Monday afternoon at home against Thiel ... Two Geneva victories on Monday would put them in a position to potentially accept an at-large bid to the NCCAA National Tournament in West Palm Beach, Fla. next week ... **Julie DiLorenzo** pitched 11 scoreless innings vs. WU in picking up a pair of victories to move her record to 20-9 on the season ... She is just one win and five strikeouts away from tying both Geneva single season records ... At the plate, DiLorenzo's sacrifice fly in the bottom of the seventh was the only run of the game before Geneva exploded for a 9-1 win in game two.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (18-15)



The Bearcats went 3-3 on the final week of the season to finish with an 18-15 record, the second best in the 25-year history of the program ... **Maria Adams** enjoyed a monster week at the plate, recording at least two hits in all six games, and going 16-for-25 in the span with seven RBIs ... After falling 7-1 in the opener vs. W&J, the Bearcats won the nightcap 6-3 in dramatic fashion, with **Emily Petrowsky** belting her school-record sixth home run of the season in the seventh, a three-run job ... SVC wrapped up the season Saturday with a sweep of Chatham by scores of 5-1 and 8-7 ... In the nightcap, the Bearcats trailed 7-1 after four innings, but the comeback was capped off with **Olivia Dongilla's** RBI single in the eighth.

Thomas More Saints (19-17, 11-3 PAC)



The Saints went 1-3 last week as it dropped a double-header with Bethany and split a doubleheader with Westminster ... Offensively last week the Saints were led by LF **Angie Sandmann**, who batted .455 as she was five-for-11 with a double and two runs batted-in ... In the pitching circle, **Dana Bors** had a 2.69 earned run average as she pitched 13 innings giving up eight runs (five earned) on 15 hits and struck out 18 ... For the season the Saints are led at the plate by 1B **Brittany Wegman**, who is batting .484 as she is 46-for-95 with eight home runs, 14 doubles, 31 runs batted-in and 40 runs scored ... On the mound **Bors** has a 1.67 ERA and an 11-7 record as she has pitched 109 innings giving up 33 runs (26 earned) on 91 hits and striking out 97.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (13-19, 6-8 PAC)



The 2010 softball season came to an end for Waynesburg University, despite a pair of wins against PAC rival Grove City during a 2-2 week ... The Jackets got a sterling pitching effort from junior **Amanda Baughman**, who allowed just two singles in Waynesburg's 4-0 shutout of Grove City ... Baughman also drove in the game-winning run in Waynesburg's 5-4 triumph over the Wolverines ... The Yellow Jackets ended their season with a road sweep at the hands of Geneva.

Grove City Wolverines (12-23, 5-9 PAC)




Grove City's charge to the conference tournament came to an abrupt end last week as the Wolverines dropped a pair of PAC doubleheaders at home ... Waynesburg took two games from GCC Wednesday ... Saturday, Grove City needed two wins over Thiel to earn the final tournament berth ... Grove City led 3-0 in the sixth inning of the opener but ultimately dropped a 5-3 decision ... Pitcher **Lauren Pennell** allowed just two hits and no runs in five innings against Thiel ... Grove City honored seniors **Jessica Hodge** and **Heidi Lohr** prior to Saturday's doubleheader ... Lohr hit .455 for the week ... She is on a five-game hitting streak ... The Wolverines will close the season Tuesday with a doubleheader at La Roche.

Thiel Tomcats (18-16, 8-6 PAC)



Thiel split its Wednesday doubleheader against Geneva, picking up the game one victory 3-0, while dropping game two 0-3 ... The Tomcats were then swept on Thursday by Bethany by scores of, 2-8 and 4-5 ... The team rallied back in the final two innings of game one against Grove City to win, 5-3, clinching the fourth seed in the PAC Tournament and then picked up the game two victory, 5-2, for good measure ... **Melissa Rankin** pushed the Tomcats to the game one victory with a go-ahead two run home run that sealed the contest ... **Kristen Moreland** picked up the game two victory, going seven complete innings, allowing two earned runs on eight hits.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (12-24, 3-11 PAC)



W&J wrapped up its 2010 conference schedule last week dropping a pair of games at Bethany (3-1; 7-1) ... The Presidents opened the week with a 7-1 triumph over Saint Vincent, but they couldn't complete the sweep as the Bearcats rallied in the seventh inning to pick up a 6-3 victory in game two ... This season marks the first time the Presidents have not qualified for the PAC Tourney since the conference went to the four-team, double-elimination format in 2006 ... Junior 3B **Victoria Doerschner** has paced the W&J offense as she hit .327 on the season with 26 RBI and 21 runs scored ... She also leads the team doubles (9) and home runs (5) ... The Presidents will wrap up 2010 May 4 when they travel to Muskingum for a 3:30 p.m. doubleheader.

Westminster Titans (24-14, 10-4 PAC)



Westminster locked up the No. 3 seed in this week's PAC Tourney at Bethany by going 4-2 last week including 3-1 in PAC games ... The Titans split at Ursuline Tuesday, before beating Chatham twice at home by identical 13-0 scores Wednesday ... The Titans then split with Thomas More, winning 1-0 and losing 11-3 ... 1B **Jennifer Emery** batted .471 (8-17) during the week and DH/SS **Katie Hughes** batted .500 (8-16) ... P **Lis Schulz** posted a 3-0 record with a 0.74 ERA during the week as she made four starts and surrendered just two runs, nine hits and two walks in 19 innings with 12 strikeouts ... In a 1-0 shutout of Thomas More on Saturday, she earned the win by pitching a complete-game seven innings with four hits, a walk and five strikeouts.
