Also competing for the women was sophomore Kaitlyn Black, who placed sixth out of 18 in the 200 (27.72) and seventh out of 14 in the 400 (1:02.49) ... For the men, freshman Nathanial Hensh tied one of the oldest remaining Bethany records and was the top collegiate finisher in the pole vault by placing second after clearing 14-0 ... Hensh equaled the 1985 Bethany record that was set by Dave Douglas.

After spending an entire week training in Myrtle Beach, S.C., the Westminster men's and women's track & field teams opened up their 2010 outdoor seasons on March 13 at the Coastal Carolina Invitational ... The unscored
