Senior - throws Westmoreland City, Pa./Norwin H.S.

Hadbavny captured both the discus (158-4 1/2) and the shot put (48-2) and finished sixth in the javelin (160-4) at the Slippery Rock University Invitational in Slippery Rock,. Pa. He qualified for the ECAC Championships in both of his winning events and broke his own school record (158-4) while qualifying provisionally for the NCAA Championships in the discus.

Also nominated was sophomore **Justin Fowler** of Grove City, senior **Adam Crawford** of Thiel, and senior **Ivan Hawkins** of Waynesburg.

Junior Mark Murchie took second in the 400 while junior Jesse Sunquist finished second in the 400 hurdles ... Sophomore Justin Fowler took second in the discus ... Grove City will compete in Carnegie Mellon's West Penn Championships next Saturday.



Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel men's and women's outdoor track and field teams finished with three individual winners at Saturday's unscored Jopson Invitational, hosted by Bridgewater College ... Senior **Kandiace Gibson** won the women's 100-meter dash (13.38) ... Senior **Libby Purdy** won the

women's javelin (123-6.5) while senior **Adam Crawford** won the men's javelin (161-2.5) ... Sophomore **Anthony McCorvey** finished second in the triple jump (43-8), third in the long jump (20-9.5) and fourth in the high jump (6-0) ... Freshman **Dorran Coley** ran to a second-place finish in the 110-meter hurdles (15.59) ... Freshman **Gary Peays** finished second in the 400-meter dash (49.91), while freshman **Steve Witherspoon** was second in the 100 (11.29).

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jacket track & field teams opened the 2006 season under head coach Jason Falvo at the Slippery Rock Invitational Saturday ... Sophomore **Michelle Propst** posted impressive times in both the 800 and 1500-meters and the 4 x 400 meter relay ... Propst, along with **April Loving**, **Delfesha Clark** and Kaci

Hlad won the 4 x 400 with a time of 4:33.84 ... On the men's side, sophomore **Nick Staffieri** won the high jump (5-4), Heath Piper won the 10,000 meter run (37:07:32) and the men's 4 x 100 relay team finished second with a time of 44.33, which qualifies them for ECACs ... The relay team featured **Eric Daniels**, **Dominick Hunter**, **Nick Emley** and **Ivan Hawkins** ... Hawkins finished the 100-meter dash in fifth place (11.35), the best time of any non-scholarship athlete.



Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's & women's track & field teams competed this weekend at the unscored Slippery Rock Invitational ... Leading the way for the Titan men was senior **Adam Hadbavny**, who captured both the discus (158-4 1/2) and the shot put (48-2), qualifying for the ECAC Championships and in both events and breaking his own school record (158-4) while qualifying provisionally for the NCAA Championships in the discus ... The Lady Titans were paced by sophomore **Jessica Cooper**, who set a new school record and

qualified for the ECAC Championships (provisionally for the NCAA Championships) after capturing the high jump with a mark of 5-5.
