# **CARLIE ROBERTS Grove City College**

6-0 junior middle hitter Union City, Pa./Union CityH.S.

Roberts earned Tournament MVP honors at the Oberlin Invitational Saturday after leading Grove City to its first tournament title in four years. She accumulated 53 kills in four matches, including a 14-kill effort in the title match against Bethany. She also had 15 kills in a win over Bluffton and had a 14-kill, seven-block effort against Ohio Wesleyan.

Also nominated was sophomore OH Lauren Spegal of Bethany, junior S Erin Plaso of Thiel, senior LIB Laura Wiegele of Thomas More, senior MH/OH Brittany Morrow of Waynesburg, and sophomore OH Diana Conzett of Westminster.

### **Bethany Bison**

The Bison reached the championship game of the Oberlin Tournament before falling to Grove City in three sets ... Bethany swept La Roche and Pitt-Greensburg before squeezing past host Oberlin to reach the final ... Sophomore

**Lauren Spegal** earned All-Tournament team honors after recording 54 kills and 11 aces during the four matches ... In addition to her 3.86 kills per game average, Spegal posed a .345 hitting percentage ... Senior **Peggy Emmerling** tallied 37 kills and 14 blocks, including nine solos, during the weekend ... Senior **Linzy Turner** amassed 36 kills, including 18 in the five-game win over Oberlin.



## **Grove City Wolverines**

Grove City won the Oberlin Tournament Saturday, going 3-1 over the weekend ... Grove City swept PAC rival Bethany Saturday in the championship match ... Junior MH Carlie Roberts earned the tournament's MVP award

after accumulating 53 kills in four matches, including 14 in the title match ... Sophomore MH **Brittany Anderson** posted 13 kills and four blocks in the championship match ... Grove City swept Bluffton and Lake Erie in pool play Friday afternoon ... The Wolverines closed pool play Saturday with a 3-2 loss to Ohio Wesleyan but still advanced to the title match ... Waynesburg posted victories over Kenyon and Case Western Reserve in the eight-team invite with losses to Defiance and Calvin ... Senior **Brittany Morrow** earned all-tournament honors after averaging

1.93 kills per game and 2.93 digs per game ... The Jackets opened the tournament with a five-game loss to Defiance on Friday, 2-3, before sweeping Kenyon, 3-0 ... Against Kenyon, sophomore **Lorelle Marker** led the way with 12 kills and five total blocks ... Freshman Amanda Staudt set up 33 assists ... Marker, along with **Laurie Linder** and **Kimberly Wilson**, all reached a team-best 13 kills in the three-game victory over Case Western Reserve.



### Westminster Titans

Westminster split four matches to open the 2005 season with a third-place finish at the Mount Union Invitational this weekend ... In the opener against the host Purple Raiders, sophomore OH **Diana Conzett** led the team with nine kills, followed by senior OH **Erin Hinks** with eight ... Junior **Rachael Cooper** set up a team-high 18 assists ...
