LINZY TURNER **Bethany College** 5-9 sophomore hitter Weireton, W.Va./Weir H.S.

Turner led the Bison to a 3-1 win over La Roche in the team's only match of the week. She posted team-high totals of 14 kills and 12 digs, the team's first double-double of the season,

while adding four service aces in the victory.

Also nominated was senior OH Kate DiMarco of Grove City, sophomore S Erin Plaso of Thiel, senior OH Jerica Lamens of Washington & Jefferson, and sophomore MH Katie McDermott of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany played in one match last week, on Sept. 14, against La Roche College ... It was the 2004 home opener for the Bison ... After losing the first game of the match, 31-29, the Bison came back to win the next three games, 30-25, 30-23 and 30-19 ... Sophomore Linzy Turner led the way with 14 kills and 12 digs, recording the first double-double for the Bison this season ... She also added four service aces ... Lauren Spegal (13) and Peggy Emmerling (11) also earned double-digit kills, while freshman Michelle Fowler led the squad with 14 digs ... Angelina Allen added 12 digs and four kills ... Lindsey Cowser had 31 assists.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J posted a 2-2 record this past weekend at the Case Western Reserve Tournament in Cleveland, Ohio ... Senior OH Jerica Lamens totaled 17 kills and 11 digs in the opening round loss to John Carroll, while junior libero Anne Reynolds picked up a season-high 34 digs ... Lamens and freshman OH Beth Mihalik both totaled a team-high 10 kills in W&J's 3-1 victory over Oberlin ... Lamens led the Presidents in the win over the Lady Titans with 16 kills, 17 digs and two aces ... Sophomore S Jamie Gullen also added 21 assists, eight digs and four kills ... Lamens and junior MH Rebecca Fletcher both collected six kills in the loss to Urbana ... W&J returns to action on Saturday when it takes on Marietta and Hiram at Waynesburg.

Tinney also had two dozen kills at Allegheny while senior Rachel Peterson had 18 kills against Allegheny ... Melissa Lawton had 35 digs against Allegheny ... Head coach Susan Roberts now has 498 overall career victories and will look to earn her 500th overall victory this weekend at the Ohio Wesleyan Tournament.
