5-11 senior middle blocker Covington, Ky./Notre Dame Academy H.S.

Lape posted 27 kills in two matches Sunday (3.38 kpg) as the Saints won two PAC matchups in two states, topping Washington & Jefferson 3-2 before posting a 3-0 sweep at Bethany. She added seven blocks and a .310 attack percentage in the two matches as TMC improved to 3-0 in the PAC.

Bethany snapped a six-game losing streak but lost its PAC opener during a 1-3 week ... The first match of the week was a tight contest with Carlow, who slipped away with a 3-1 victory ... **Peggy Emmerling** and **Linzy Turner** had 15

kills each and **Lauren Spegal** had 14 ... At the Point Park tri-match Saturday, BC split, falling to the host school 3-0 before sweeping Hilbert 3-0 ... Spegal had 12 kills and 25 digs in the Point Park loss and also posted a team-high eight kills in the Hilbert victory ... Against Thomas More, Bethany held an 11-10 lead in the first game but the Saints scored 13 of the next 14 points en route to a 30-20 game one win and went on to the sweep ...
